My name is Leslie Goolsby...

I grew up with a Mother that was Antioch Orthodox. As with the Orthodox faith your heritage and language correspond with the Orthodox name. You are probably most familiar with the Greek & the Russian which are the most recognized. The Antioch is the Lebanese sect of the Orthodox faith. I am second generation American. The Orthodox religion as well as my teaching is steeped largely in tradition. While my Mother was not a faithful church attendee. I never saw my father attend church at all. As a matter of fact, as a child I thought most men did not believe in God and it was only for women and very unusual men.

My walk of faith is probably very similar to most people. I wasn't raised in a weekly church environment, had no Sunday School. Most of my Christian faith was brought to me at the kitchen table of my Grandmother, a woman that was deep in faith. I still rely on some of the messages she gave me.

After a childhood fraught with pain from an alcoholic abusive father, he finally at the age of 9 abandoned and threw me away. I spent my adult years wandering through life with no real definition. Sunday was just another day of the week and while I always believed in God like most people, I really didn't believe he was there for just me. I have had failed marriages with men who had no spiritual qualities. As a matter of fact, most of those times the cycle was repeated with deception and abuse.

Then I went through a deep depression brought on by the many bad choices I had made in my life. I spent many of those days working and crying at the same time. People would ask what are you crying about and I could never say. It was just a constant feeling of doom in my life. Physically I was as bad as I was mentally, I was 100 lbs. overweight, I was covered in shingles and could hardly move at times, and I was only 33 years old.

At this time in my life my Aunt would tell me God is here for you, calling you. I can remember looking at her with the upmost sincerity and saying: "Do you really believe that"? Because I didn't. I wish I could tell you this was my "aha" moment. That I gave my life over to Christ right then and there. While I still desperately needed something, I just couldn't hold on to that then. I was still turning away. Not able to believe that He was there for me. Over the next several years life went on. I tried to get closer with God but like most people the more I reached out the more the Devil held on. One night as I was crying with my Grandmother. I told her. I don't know what is wrong with me, why can't I do better than this? Why can't I fight this feeling? She told me: You are fighting within my child. This is not the battle within you. When you have these horrible thoughts and feelings, those aren't yours. That's the devil, trying to hold on to you. You can't fight him by yourself. You must call on God. You must turn this battle over to Him if you ever want to win. WIN I thought I couldn't even fathom winning. I was just trying to survive much less win. But in that message, I was able to hold onto one thing. She gave me the enemy. See I was so sure I was the enemy, and I had no idea how to deal with that. But an enemy that I knew enough about that I knew how to conquer. That was different! So, day by day and



I would pray each night for God to bring me someone to share my life with. Someone that was kind, loving and genuine. That day came and not only did he bring someone that had all the qualities I asked for, as usual, God gave me more than I asked and blessed me abundantly.

My husband is in the true way of the Bible my spiritual leader. He has knowledge and grace that I only hope to attain. Then the Lord brought me to the Chambersville Methodist Church on one January day. I walked in those doors and felt the love and family that I had always hungered for.

God led me to stay in that church and after only a year there He led us again to adopt our child. My child was in a place that she could not stay. The Lord wanted her out of there. He called on me to take her. I had never dreamed of having a child as life was too much of a struggle, and my husband was way beyond the years of wanting children. But as in the story of Sarah, the Lord looked at it differently and brought us that child, a child to LOVE.

My Testimony by Judith Hastings


It amazes me how God can take a woman, so afraid of her own shadow, always trying to please everyone just so they would like her, and deliver her from so many fears that had her so bound, she could hardly speak at times. This is what He did for me, and so much more. I grew up in the country, not a lot of friends maybe one or two at the most and they were not close friends. I thought I was ugly, because that is how my mother would introduce me to others. I was so broken, beyond repair, or so I thought.

I had accepted Christ when I was seven years old, but because I was never taught that God could heal the inner hurts, or set one free from bondage it took me until I was forty-five years old to learn what an intimate relationship with Christ was. In 1987 I had an encounter with God that took me beyond anything I had ever experienced. All my children were grown now, and lived away from home on their own, and it was just my husband and I. I was feeling desperate that day. My husband was a functioning alcoholic. He was not a mean drunk, nor did he ever drink on the job, but the minute he got home from work he would start drinking and not stop until he went to bed. He was a good provider, a good father, and very loving husband. But I was so tired of his drinking, and I was missing my children. It was my daughter's birthday and I was weepy because I was not there to celebrate with her. Those two elements drove me into the arms of Jesus on September 29th 1987 in my living room. I got down on my knees and started talking to him like I never had before. I was desperate for change. I was tired of what I called a yoyo life with Him. Why could I not stay faithful to him? Why was there never any victory in my life? My words to Him on that day were; "God, I'm tired of trying, I'm tired of my life and always trying so hard to live for you, I keep failing you. It has been nothing but a yo-yo life with you. Either I'm up and things seem to go well for a while, or I'm down, dangling at the end of the string. Depressed, tired and weary. If YOU are God. then show me how to live a constant walk with YOU. I am going to try one more time and if I fail this time, I will go to hell and it will be Your fault for not showing me or caring enough to save me." I was desperate and angry. For two hours that afternoon I was on the floor before

Him pouring out my heart and repenting of failing Him. But then something strange happened. All of a sudden, I felt His presence unlike never before and a peace came over me that I could not explain. Then I heard Him speak to me audible, He said, "MY daughter, I have never left you, I chose you and now I will show you what total surrender to me is like." The joy that filled my heart and soul was so over whelming, all I could do was praise HIM. I knew He was there with me in that room that day.

Fast forward approximately three months later. I had been absorbing the word. understanding things I never had before. It was just a few days before Christmas, I would wake up at night hearing Him call my name, saying, "Judy, come and spend time with me," So I would get up and go talk with Him. This particular night was so peaceful. MY husband was sound asleep in the bedroom, I spent about two hours talking and visiting with Him. I felt His love in a tangible way. I got up off the floor and set in the recliner for a few minutes, just loving Him with praise. Then all of a sudden, I felt a breeze across my right cheek. and then to my utter surprise, I felt two lips on my cheek and the wetness of a kiss. All I could do was sit there and cry with sheer joy and a heart so full of love I thought my heart would burst. I can remember it so clearly, how it felt, and the love that permeated that room. This was a gift to me that I will forever cherish.

Four days later, as we were talking once again, Jesus said to me." Judy give me a twentyone day fast and I will give you your heart's desire." I said to Him, "Yes, Lord, but can I start on the first of January, it will be easier for me to keep track of." He laughed and said "Yes". So on January one of 1988 I started a fast. I had never fasted in my life. I also worked in a deli eight hours a day; breakfast and lunch. I also had to cook meals for my husband each day. But I did it with His help and He did give me my heart's desire. All of my family came to the Lord, and my husband was the first, and was instantly delivered from alcohol and tobacco. That was on the second day of the fast, and I never said a word to him about God, fasting or pushed him to repent. He had gone to bed, I was watching Christian television and reading my Bible. All of a sudden he came out of the bedroom, with tears running down his face, did not say a word to me, he went to the phone and called the television station on TBN network and said, "I just want to make a public confession that I just accepted Christ for my Lord and Savior." Then he turned to me and said, "I have been watching you, and I want what you have," Oh my heart was indeed

full. By the time the twenty-one day was over, we got to lead all three of our children to God. That is how great our God is.

Fast forward again, to 2010, My husband was battling gout in his ankle, and it was a pretty bad case of it. On October eighth, after an extremely painful night, he decided to go to the doctor again. But this time he said he wanted to go the VA hospital not just to the clinic. We got into the pickup, and started out on the two-hour drive to the VA hospital. We were about half an hour from it and he died while driving the truck. I was frantic! I could not get to the pedals or the gear shift (it was an older pick up) David, my husband was a very big man, 6'3" and broad shoulders, he took up a lot of room. We had gone off the road into the center of the medium on a state highway. headed for the center cement divider that crossed over another freeway below and I could not get the truck stopped. I cried out to God, "Help me!" David set up and put his foot on the brake and slowed the truck down enough so I could shift it down and stop it. David was dead, his eyes still rolled back in his head when this occurred. When the paramedics arrived in the ambulance, the police; they all said it was a miracle. Less than 60 feet from the overpass and I would have been killed, possible killing

someone else on the freeway below. God was good.

Over the next few months God taught me that He was my provider. And over the past nine years I have once again came to a greater relationship and understanding of all that He is to me. There are many more testimonies I could share throughout these past years; of God loving care and faithfulness, about His teaching me, breaking lifelong chains in areas that were hidden for so many years, hurts, misunderstandings, the death of both of my sons, my sisters battle with cancer and the death of my brother. All of these have a testimony of their own. and it would be way too long to write them all here.

I have learned that God is faithful. Not just in some areas, but in every aspect of our lives. He cares so deeply for His children. His love goes way beyond the cross, that was just the price He paid for our admission to heaven. If you don't know Jesus, there is always someone available to walk you through the process. Seek someone out. God will never disappoint you.



MY ETERNAL DECISION

Testimony

I was not raised in a Christian home. I would not say we were atheist or agnostic; we just did not practice Christianity or any religion, and I was not being made into a disciple and genuine believer of JESUS CHRIST as my LORD and SAVIOR. This was of no fault to my parents necessarily as they did not grow up in a Christian home either. My childhood was difficult and any faith I had in GOD was by HIS grace alone and not anything I did or anyone around me. I love my parents and have a wonderful relationship with them, but their divorce when I was around 12 years old left a void in me that resulted in only trusting myself (certainly not God) and making bad decisions like disobedience and drinking alcohol. Growing up there were glimpses in my life of belief in GOD, but nothing concrete that I could grow in relationship with HIM.

I am happily married now to my wife Dana of 13 years, and we have two daughters together. My wife grew up in a Christian home being a "PK" or Pastor's Kid; her father was a Lutheran Pastor. I am a former police officer and currently work for the State of Illinois as an investigator. Riding Point With Dave Harvey....

INEFFECTIVE AND UNPRODUCTIVE

2 Peter 1:5-9 5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; 6 and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; 7 and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. 8 For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 But if anyone does not have them, he is nearsighted and blind, and has forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins.

Nobody wants to be "ineffective and unproductive" or at least I sure hope that nobody wants to be like that; especially cowboys and cowgirls. We spent a bunch of time trying to improve our riding skills, our horsemanship abilities and working with our horses to make sure that they are preforming to the top of their capabilities. We feed, train, strive and spend major amounts of time, energy and money to keep reaching to a higher level of success as keepers of this beautiful animal the LORD has blessed us with. So, I think I can eliminate cowboy and cowgirls from the ranks of wanting to be "ineffective and unproductive" at least in their horsemanship. But, what about your Christian walk? What about your service to the LORD? What about being CHRIST-like in your daily life as a child of GOD and a parent, a brother or

sister or as a co-worker or just as a friend to those you know or have just met.

I know, I know; I am riding a trail that many of us just don't want to ride; and especially talk about. It is so much more enjoyable to talk about horsemanship, training and horse activities then it is to talk about our service to the LORD. To the reining horseman, it is all about lead changes, turns and stops. To the roper, it is about loops and times and the cutting horseman, it is of course the gittin' in the dirt, nose to nose. And of course, we can't forget about the "can chasing" barrel racers, the "over the poles" hunter/jumper riders, or the "let's hit the trails" trail rider and all of the horse riders and lovers in between. So, if we took what Peter is teaching and look at it as a pattern to follow to sharpen and hone our horsemanship riding and training skills, many of us would get real interested in it if we thought it would benefit us as we spend time in the saddle.

Well, let's just look at it "from the back of a horse, so to speak." I'm in the saddle and I am wanting to take that jump, but it sure looks kind of high; really about 6 feet. That is exactually how we feel when we are thinking that we should talk to that person; family member, loved one, friend or stranger about JESUS CHRIST and the wonderful, free plan of "eternal salvation" that HE has provided to all who will believe in HIM. You see folks, our faith is a little on the weak side; it is needing a good boost of HOLY SPIRIT spurring to move us to know that we have the LORD and the Power of the HOLY SPIRIT there with us to share our testimony and the LOVE of JESUS CHRIST as HE gives us the words to speak. Suddenly our faith will reach the 17 hands level and we will start saying the words that the HOLY SPIRIT gives us and we will tell the TRUTH of JESUS CHRIST. Faith will grow and grow and grow, because you will realize you can share JESUS CHRIST to the lost, the hurting and those that the LORD has placed in your trail of life.

Next, we start seeking the good in that person and the ways to reveal the GOODNESS of JESUS CHRIST to them. As we continue to build our faith, we will start sharing our knowledge of how JESUS CHRIST has changed our life and how HE has made a big difference in every part of our lives. We suddenly have the strength and peace to stay the course and persevere under the attacks of the adversary and stay in the saddle on this ride of life.

The CHRIST-like walk that makes us different in this lost world will be exposed through our words, actions and thoughts that will be seen by those around us to reveal JESUS CHRIST and our desire to be a GODLY person in this life. We will seek to be different because HE has called us to be different to attract those that are seeking help, that are hurting and that are so greatly in need of the SAVIOR. GODLY cowboys and cowgirls will speak volumes to those whose lives are being destroyed by the devil, and that is exactually what we are called to be; GODLY. The GODLYNESS will stimulate kindness and there will be a CHRIST-like LOVE for that person; family member, loved one or stranger, and you will start seeing them through the eyes of the SAVIOR WHO died on the cross for them. Your heart will yearn to share JESUS CHRIST with them and the wonderful plan of salvation that changed your life and will certainly change theirs.

Cowboys and Cowgirls, it will work; just try it. You can use these principles training your horse or sharing JESUS CHRIST and they will work, in the NAME OF JESUS, they will work. 





As time went on, I saw old ways of mine, I knew you were coming, I just thought I had more time.


I begin to live my life the way I always had. Oh, somechoices we make are so very bad. I knew you were coming Lord I didn't think it'd be today.
