Toward the end of the Civil War, his toes stuck out of his shoes, pants were burned to his knees from standing so close to fires on cold winter nights, shirt had buttons missing, and also a shell jacket had a large hole in it. His name was James McNeilly, Chaplain with the 49th Tennessee. One of his favorite Scriptures was II Timothy 4:5, "But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry." Chaplains, like James McNeilly, have always been a part of American history, serving, sacrificing, giving words of encouragement, the words that come from a Book they cherish and revere.

Was the Civil War the first war that was served by chaplains? According to America's God and Country Encyclopedia by William J. Federer, it was on July 9, 1776 the Continental Congress authorized the Continental Army to provide chaplains for their troops. General George Washington then issued the order to his troops, stating, "The General hopes and trusts that every officer and man, will endeavor so to live, and act, as becomes a Christian Soldier defending the dearest Rights and Liberties of his country."

Here's a question that some will ask. Is there a need for chaplains in the day that we live in? According to these statistics, the answer is yes, a resounding yes! Three thousand eight hundred Americans die by suicide every year. Suicide is the third leading cause of death for individuals between the ages of 15-24 and the second leading cause of death for individuals between the ages of 24-35. An average of one person dies by suicide every 16.2 minutes. Each suicide intimately affects at least six other people.

Every true born-again Christian should be able to see there is an evil attack on America's youth. It's like a dark cloud that hovers over and threatens our very existence. Who is willing to pray and bring down these strongholds? Who is willing to carry the message of hope to a generation that has been labeled "a hopeless generation"? Who is willing to endure afflictions and to do the work of an evangelist like James McNeilly? In Matthew 9:37-38 Jesus said to look around and see that the harvests are plenty, but the workers are few. Then Jesus stated, "Pray to the Lord of harvest that there will be workers in the field." The following should be a part of our daily prayers.

"Heavenly Father, there are so many people that are hurting, people bound by addictions and see no way out. Lord, we need an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to break these chains of addictions and people will feel the awesome joy of Your Salvation. Now, Lord of Harvest, we pray that you will rise up an army of youth that will be workers in the field. An army of youth, an army of those who are not religious, but regenerated. In Jesus Name I pray Amen."

Spilled Paint

My first thought for my testimony consisted of what others had done to me in my early life and how I worked to be an overcomer. But the Lord laid it on my heart to testify about what I had done to myself.

My backstory – I was saved at church camp and baptized when I was ten years old. I felt the Lord so close to me during the tumultuous years of abuse and neglect I endured as a child. I experienced fear and anxiety at extreme levels and would often sing at night in my bed to comfort myself. Jesus was right there and heard my songs.

Enough of that – on to the meat of it. The "spilled paint" came back to me when the Lord was giving me instructions in what to share, and it involves my younger sister. She was the family pet. Blond, petite and cute and I knew she was favored over me, especially by our mother. I never understood how jealous I was of her until much later in life. She was also the family tattletale and loved getting me into trouble and pulling my strings. Think Nellie Olson and you have my mental image of her.

There was a painting project going on in our kitchen, I was 11 and she was around 8 and she came through the back-kitchen door and stuck her tongue out at me. (Her signature move) the open can of paint was sitting on the floor on some spread out newspapers and I impulsively jumped over the can of paint with intentions of punching my sister for teasing me. I "spilled the paint" – I ran in a panic and grabbed towels and tried to clean it up before my Mom and Step-Dad saw what I had done. No amount of anything my sister did to me could justify my action. I had lost my self-control or maybe even lacked it all together.

Fast forward 7 years. I was 18 years old and getting out of the toxic environment I grew up in. I had so much self-talk about what I would do when I got away from them. (I had stayed in church most of my teen years) but I was Never going to allow anyone to hurt me or control me ever again. I married a young man a few years older than I was, had two kids and started to see that this was Not what I thought it was going to be.

I set out on my own with two little boys and the misconception that I was all they needed. I didn't want to need anyone. The strength I projected to the world didn't mesh with the anxiety and the overwhelming sense of responsibility I put on myself. I kept that part

"just for me". I called out to the Lord when I got in a jam and asked Him why He was punishing me. I hadn't really dealt with my wounded self and felt I deserved a free pass from my mistakes because after all, I was a victim. (At this point no one knew this.)

What I was doing was "spilling the paint". There was no hiding some of the messes I made. I had put God on the back burner for a while. I slopped around through the seasons of my life. Looking back, I can see the total tailspin I was in, the things I didn't do for my kids, the things I did to hurt myself.

Things started to turn around a few years after Joe and I were married. Neither one of us was living for the Lord at this point, but we knew where we stood in our beliefs. I told his Uncle Holly, who married us, to leave the obey part out of our vows. Wow! Who was 12

Earlier in our relationship I opened up to Joe while we were walking in the mountains about my early years. It took me 36 years to tell someone. I think I had begun to realize that I needed to start dealing with this and wanted him to know what he was getting into. We were later invited to church by his cousin's little girls to see them in their Christmas program. We have been there ever since. We both let Christ back into our lives and couldn't be happier. Slowly Jesus has helped me clean up the paint. He never left me. I left Him with the idea that I could fix myself. I am so thankful that He didn't give up on me!

Today I stand in the light of a Father who loves me unconditionally and covers me with His Grace.

Life – we are all in it. Sometimes people disappointment us big time, sometimes we may have done a no-no, sometimes we weren't aware of doing anything amiss.



Dear Brother Dave,

I have seen your Christian Ranchman newspaper many times, but never felt the pull to pick it up and read it. Then the other day a friend of mine received his at mail call and I had to take this opportunity to see what I was missing.

My childhood was in a broken home where I spent more time covering bruises than getting hugs and while I know no one should ever be forced to go through that, I do not blame my parents. I know I was not the easiest child to manage and at the time they too were lost.

It wasn't until my relationship with a preacher's daughter that I fell in love with the Word of Christ. It was at this time that I also knew I had a much deeper calling to serve the Lord. I knew that God had brought me to this family because I was meant to be a minister of the Word, but this would not come to pass as my struggles with anger, resentment, and drinking caused everything I had to be taken away.

For the next several years, I refused to so much as look at a church when I passed it. I was angry with God, angry with myself, and did not want to live in this world for another second. I was having multiple affairs, drinking daily, and being abusive to my wife. I had even begun to shut out my family as I isolated myself more and more.

Then in June of 2016 as my marriage fell apart, I was arrested and sentenced to 15 years in the Arkansas Department of Corrections. Just prior to my sentencing I attempted suicide, but was unsuccessful as the Lord told me that He had a purpose for me that I had yet to fulfill. While in county jail awaiting transfer to state custody, I found my purpose.

I began a Bible study in our pod, that was initially meant to be a one-on-one, and by the end of the first week we had over half of the pod in one tiny cell hearing the Word. I remember the tears and just raw emotion that occurred during our Easter Bible Study that night. It was at that moment that I knew I couldn't run from the Lord any longer. That I had to answer His call and became the servant he needed me to be.

I have now begun the process of trying to find a Bible college that I can complete while I am incarcerated. I have been trying to be a religious advisor to those around me and to my family. I am beginning the process of trying to organize a prison ministry that upon my release I will be able to lead and possibly bring hope to a group that has so little to have hope about.

There is no greater feeling than knowing the Lord and feeling the power of His touch in your life. It is my life's mission to use the calling God has given me to change the lives of those lost to Him and I can't wait to start this process. Reading the words in the testimony by Kristin Allen in the September/October 2019 issue I was again reminded of the power of God's hand on the lives

of those who freely seek Him.

I thank you for all that you do and would like to be added to the Christian Ranchman mailing list, be sent Bible studies, to be sent info as how I can obtain a Cowboys for Christ Bible, and how I can start a Cowboys for Christ ministry, and have you possibly come give a service at our unit, and to be as involved as possible with helping to spread the Word of God.

You and your organization truly are a blessing and I thank you for reminding me of the true power of ministry.




