
On June 26th-27th, the Redeemed Riders Chapter was represented at the National Championship Weekend held at the Tri-State Expo Center in McDonald, Tennessee, just north of Chattanooga. The event was organized by YEDA, the Youth Equestrian Development Association.

On Saturday, Chaplain Skeeter Spaulding manned a booth to distribute Cowboy For Christ literature and Bibles. On Sunday, he was joined by Chaplain T.W. Lawrence. They gave the opening prayer to Sunday's event, attended by more than 250 event riders, plus their families and coaches. Skeeter gave a well-received devotional at a small service in the picnic area near the concession stand. He spoke about Jesus coming to be a servant as a man, but that He will come as a ruler on a white horse the second time.

While the riders were competing in the dozens of national championship events, Skeeter and T.W. were busy talking with event goers and stamping individual horseshoes with a person's name on it. They call that The Horseshoe Ministry. There were 40-50 horseshoes stamped that day, including the last one done on Skeeter's truck tailgate after he'd already packed up his equipment for the day. But Skeeter can never say no to that kind of a request.

Several things make the YEDA events different. All riders must be in good standing in school, whether high school or college. And each rider must wear a clean starched cotton shirt pre-approved by YEDA. But the most interesting aspect is the fact that each rider only competes on a horse he or she has met literally minutes before entering the arena. The idea is to make each rider adaptable to an individual horse's personality and behavior. A lot of training goes into that.

YEDA was pleased with the contributions made by Cowboys For Christ at their event, and asked us to come back whenever there was one of their events at the Tri-State Expo Center. You bet we'll be back!

Praise Report

from Chaplain J.C. Shook

So, even with all of my accomplishments in life, even with me becoming an Ordained Chaplain, and receiving my Associates and BA degrees, this next story rates far greater to me. There was a man in this prison whom we shall call "Zek" for privacy purposes. He would constantly try and give the Christian brothers in our dorm a hard time. I was in that dorm for 3 years and never pushed my faith on him, however, I would get up early every morning and pray and study scripture.

Plus, I worked in the Chaplain's Office during that time frame setting up for services and doing baptisms. Even though Zek would give me a hard time about my faith and would try to shake me at times. I would show him love and kindness. My desire is to reflect the love of my Lord and Savior to all. One day Zek was at work here in the prison and he had a serious accident where he fell off a roof of a building and there were huge boards that fell on him. He was out of work for a while and I helped take care of him. Then one day he asked me "What Word do you have on your mind?" I was in shock and asked him "Are you asking me to share Scripture with you?" He said "Yes, tell me what Word do you have?"

This went on for several days and months. There were three passages out of many that I told him but the three I referred to most were John 3:16, John 14:6, and Romans 10:9-13. Then Zek asked me to pray for his family, his sister in particular. I would see a bit of transformation taking place. Zek was asking me to go to breakfast with him so I would go however, a possible problem for me arose. When we eat, the tables are usually segregated by race and very rarely do you see two different races seated together. It would start a fight. Zek would not sit in my section, so I took a chance and sat with him in his section. This bothered me because I didn't want to cause issues for myself. So, I prayed,

then I heard the Lord say "Stay the course and you will see". John 10:27-30. In my prayer I was asking the Lord if I should continue to eat with Zek in his section and that was the instant answer I received.

So, in the Chaplaincy, we had a special and rare three-day Revival with over one hundred volunteers that was conducted out in the recreation field (first time event.) We talked Zek into going and he went all three days, hearing music and testimonies from the volunteers and pastors. The last night we were having a Communion and the Chaplain was compelled to ask if anyone here wanted to receive Christ Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Zek stood up, repented, and accepted Jesus into his life. I cried that night and thanked the Lord. I saw a huge transformation in Zek. I had two Bibles so I loaned him my Study Bible. Since he never used a Bible, there was a lot of teaching over several months. I even helped get him enrolled into the Prisoner of Hope Bible Study as well. Zek got involved with the Church and was helping set up for services.

Well, Zek got out of prison and stays in touch with me. For Christmas, I got him a Study Bible indexed with his name on it. HE told me that he uses it daily and that he has his own place, a good job and that he had received a raise at his job. This part touched me the most. He said "J C, I go out in my spare time every week and I help the homeless and provide food and supplies for them and I also tell them Jesus loves them and share the Gospel with anyone who will listen." Praise The Lord!! I thank God for telling me to "stay the course and you will see." I ask The Lord for one more every day. Kind of like the movie Hacksaw Ridge, where private Dawson was asking the Lord for one more to save who ended up saving more than seventy-five soldiers in the battle as a medic with no weapon other than his Bible in his pocket and his faith.

It has helped me with all the testimonies. I've shared the newsletters with several girls and I'd leave it in the dayroom and someone always picked it up. After all these years I'm finally getting out!! After I finish my Safe-P program, I only have 3 months left. I believe my time wasn't in vain. I was in the desert like the Jews only, I figured out how to get out and that's by being obedient to the Lord and receiving Jesus Christ as my Savior. I also have truly been born again, and I love my Jesus and who I am today! If it took me losing everything, then it was all worth it. Because I was dead without Jesus Christ. But because He died for us, I can live again. I am going straight onto discipleship school and in one year I will be a missionary serving the Lord with all my heart and soul. I lost everyone and I have nothing, yet I am so rich with

His mercy. I give Him all the glory. The iron gates will open for me soon for freedom, but it's not what's giving me freedom. I give the glory to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I love Him so much. I was 28 when I got locked up and I just turned 42 years old this last May. I am a mother of 7 children; 5 boys and 2 girls and I will finally be able to reunite with them this Thanksgiving. Praise God, He restores what the locust ate. I've been told I have a calling and that the Lord shines through me. I pray society will see it as well. I go out alone, but not really because He goes before, beside and behind me; Jesus. Dave, I just wanted to thank you for my cowgirl Bible I got a long time ago. I passed it down to a youngster in prison to start her off on her ministry in prison, that's where I started mine. I'd love to meet you at a sermon one day to thank you in person and share my testimony. So, thank you Dave with all my heart for your words.



Riding Point With Dave Harvey...

You Can Persuade Me

Acts 26:28 Then Agrippa said to Paul, "Do you think that in such a short time you can persuade me to be a Christian?"

This is the question that King Agrippa asked the Apostle Paul after Paul had given his testimony in the presence of the king and his court. Actually, it could be a statement, as well as a question. We need to be aware of folks voicing a question when they are trying to state a need. But the response from king Agrippa

started with, "Do you think in such a short time" which certainly made it a question. Either way the Apostle Paul was ready and prepared to respond with his testimony and the Gospel of JESUS CHRIST.

The Apostle Paul took great advantage of the chance to share about JESUS CHRIST and how JESUS had totally changed Paul's life and Paul wanted to let everyone know about it and tell them how it happened. This is certainly the attitude that all Christian should have, because a personal testimony can have such an impact on the lives of others. We should never shrink from these opportunities and we should make sure that we take them as a blessing. The HOLY SPIRIT is working in your life when HE sends others to you to hear your testimony and that should stir us to be ready and willing to share at any time. Heb. 4:16 Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Touching lives for JESUS CHRIST is such a wonderful way to live your life; the life that the LORD has so graciously given you. 
