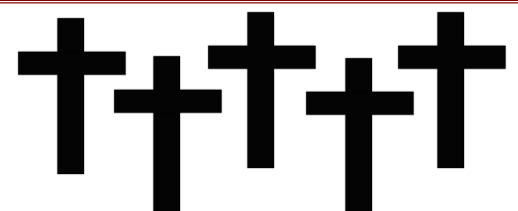

Letter and Testimony

Dear Brother Dave,

This is Jerry Hughes and I wanted to write and let you know that I really enjoyed talking to you on the phone this morning. It feels so good to be able to be out in the world. I would say "free world" but you and I both know that nothing in this world is free. Even Jesus paid. He paid the price so that we could live a (sin free) life. Amen.

I wanted to start this letter by saying that Jesus Christ is Lord! I placed an order with you for a large Cowboys For Christ belt buckle. I look forward to wearing it with pride to honor the Lord and your ministry. I also wanted to give my testimony to what the Lord has done in my life and in my family's life.

It all started when I showed up drunk to court to accept my sentence to prison for 8 years. The jailer put me in a cell by myself to help me detox from the alcohol. At this point in my life, I really didn't think I had anything to live for. I had left my wife. I lost my home, everything I loved I had lost. In my mind there was nothing left, no hope, no future! I thought life was over, maybe I would die in prison, nobody would miss me, nobody cared.

Well, one of my drinking buddies asked me if I needed anything and I told him that I'd like to have a Bible and a Lonesome Dove novel, so I'd have something to read. Well, when the books came in, don't be angry Dave, but I tossed the Bible on the little shelf they had in the single man cell, and started reading the book "Lonesome Dove." But I couldn't concentrate on the book. So, one evening I got down on my knees and asked God what He wanted from me, and He told me He didn't want me to read any novels until I got through reading the Bible from cover to cover. He told me that "I could do it." He said to give Him one hour a day, and that He would "change my life." I surrendered to

the Lord that day. I think He needed me to be at the bottom so that it would be easy for me to see all the blessings He was fixing to bring to my life. I stepped out in total faith! I mean what more could I possibly loose? I prayed for protection because I knew I was fixing to go to a violent world. And I didn't worry any cause at once I felt safe! There was no fear! I thought "it has to be that I totally surrendered!"

My first blessing. Upon my arrival to prison, I received a letter from my wife, saying that she would not give up on me, that she had been praying for me, and if I would place my faith in the Lord, that everything would be alright, that I needed to trust Him. (So, I got my wife back.)

Blessing #2. The doctor pulled a bunch of blood and found that I had Hep. B-C and my liver and kidneys were shutting down! I only weighed 143 lbs. when I got to prison. The alcohol was killing me! He said that coming to prison had probably saved my life and he said I would've died if I would've waited another 6 months. He didn't know if medication would even help. Well, I'm here to tell you, God healed me from my sickness! He took the cancer from my body! He delivered me from alcohol. Amen!

When I went to prison my wife lost our house because she could not afford it. She wrote me and asked for prayer so she could believe by faith, that the Lord would help her get another place for me, her and her son (who is grown with special needs.) And guess what? You got it! God gave us a duplex so our adult son with special needs could have his own place, but still be close enough so we could take care of him if needed! God not only gave us one home; He gave us two!! Amen.

Blessing #3. My wife wrote and told me she had been praying for my early release and that she believed God for it. Guess what? You got it!

Brother Dave, this is only a short version of the miracles and wonders that I personally have witnessed. There are too many things to tell you Brother Dave, but I will keep the letters coming to you, if you don't mind. I haven't even begun to tell you about all the miracles that happened after I found an abandoned Bible that said Cowboys For Christ Easy Read Version. After I found ya'lls Bible, people started flocking to me! They said they wanted the glow that I had. I didn't notice a glow, but people were saying that it showed that I was a changed man! Amen!

Now do you remember what I told you at the beginning? God said to give Him one hour a day, every day, and He would change my life. Dave, this is only the beginning of my changed life! There is no turning back. Some people think that going to church on Sunday only will cover them, and that is not true. When we give our lives over to God, He is with us always, 24/7. He will never leave us or forsake us; we at least owe Him one hour of those 24 hours. He's with us!

Brother Dave, I did the breakdown of a 24-hour period. 24 hours breaks down to 1460 minutes in a day, and all He asked me for is 60 minutes of that 1460. I'll never forget the sign I saw in the Warden's office that said "If someone ask you about your past, you tell them Jesus has dropped the charges." Which means, no matter what we've done in our past, we can be forgiven!! Brother Dave, thank you for letting me ramble on and like I said this is only a very, very, very, short list of the many, many, many blessings God gave given me just for giving Him 1 hour a day. And this does not include the miracles and blessing I received and the people

who I have helped lead to Christ because of your ministry and Bibles. I've got a big story to tell and let me remind you that all this happened in a 2-year time frame! Dear Fellow Christians,

I enjoy the testimonies presented in every Christian Ranchman. I have thought about sending my testimony to you for months, but never got around to it. In the latest Christian Ranchman, Dave Harvey questioned if readers had their testimony memorized. Mine is indelibly etched in my mind. Rising to the challenge, I have finally included my testimony. It was my pleasure to give a recorded testimony for the church I was attending several years ago. MY TESTIMONY

I was raised in the Free Methodist Church. My mother made sure we were

there every Sunday. In time, I became Vice President of the Youth Group, a VBS teacher and member of the choir. I carried my Bible to school and after graduation, spent a year attending a religious college. Then I joined the Marines. At first, I still attended church whenever possible. But in time that changed. My Bible just gathered dust. By the time I left, I had abandoned all Christian beliefs. On October 31, 1968, I was sent to San Francisco from Vietnam to await my discharge from the Marines. The first night there, I met a lovely lady named Barbara, who wanted nothing to do with me because she had a rule against dating Marines. I eventually persuaded her that I was only going to be there for a few weeks and would be going home, so could she just show me around San Francisco. She agreed, so we spent every day we could exploring San Francisco. By the time it came for me to leave in Mid-November, we were hopelessly in love. Needless to say, I returned to San Francisco after spending Christmas at home.

Six months later, on June 14th, we were married. Six months after that Barbara was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. In June 1970, we welcomed our daughter. When our daughter was old enough for preschool, I decided that just because I did not believe in God, she should have the right to make up her own mind. So, we sent her to a preschool run by a large non-denominational church nearby. The church had visitation teams that visited the families of the preschoolers. One night, they came to our house. The team was led by a man named Dick. And after giving their testimonies, he asked me how I felt about this. I told him that I had my own set of beliefs. He then turned to Barbara and asked her how she felt. You could have knocked me over with a feather when she said that she believed in God and Christ. With that they left. I walked them to the door and as Dick walked out, I literally bit my tongue to stop from asking him to pray for me.

Riding Point With Dave Harvey...

Die in Your Sins



John 8:24 "Therefore I told you that you will die in your sins. For if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."

Pride is a terrible evil and it is a deadly emotion, just as King Solomon tells us in **Prov 16:18** "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall." I am guessing that pride was the motivation that kept the Pharisees and Sadducees so blinded to the TRUTH of JESUS CHRIST. They above all others of GOD'S own chosen

nation of Israel should have been watching and seeking the MESSIAH. They, more than anyone else at that time, should have been wide awake of the times, the situation and especially the promise of the coming SAVIOR. It is not like HIS birth was hidden, and I am not only referring to the glorious appearing of the angels announcing HIS birth, or the shepherds who witnessed the CHRIST CHILD and went about telling everyone about the angelic happening. But mainly to the ruthless King Herod who had murdered all of the young baby boys to try to kill the coming KING. This was brought about by the appearance of the "Wise Men" seeking the new KING because they had seen the star that declared HIS birth. So, the Pharisees and the Sadducees, the religious leaders should have been on high alert and standing ready for the appearance of the promised MESSIAH, with open arms and open hearts.

Now I know that it was twenty some years later that John the Baptist came on the scene proclaiming that the KINGDOM OF GOD was at hand and that the MESSIAH would soon be revealed. I am well aware of the strained situation of the nation of Israel, being in bondage to the powerful Roman government at that time. And I am sure that this bondage and all of the foreign influence had greatly dampened the Spiritual movement of the people. But the religious leaders should have been on top of the happenings, especially with a weird dressed man drawing crowds out into the wilderness declaring repentance of their sins and baptizing those who responded, as we are told in **Matt 3:1-6** [1 In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the Desert of Judea 2 and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near." 3 This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah: "A voice of one calling in the desert, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'" 4 John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey.] It is a fact that they were there, the Pharisees and Sadducees, I mean, because John sure addressed them in **Matt 3:7-10** [7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to where he was baptizing, he said to them: "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? 8 Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. 9 And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham."] And as you can see, he wasn't very nice to them, either, as he called them a bunch of snakes. So, again I say, why were the religious leaders unknowing or uncaring and actually opposed to the arrival of the MESSIAH.

Now I want to fast forward a little to where JESUS was addressing the same group, the Pharisees and Sadducees, as it appears that they challenged HIM on numerous occasions throughout HIS ministry on this earth. In **John 8:21-24** [Then He said to them again, "I'm going away; you will look for Me, and you will die in your sin. Where I'm going, you cannot come." 22 So the Jews said again, "He won't kill Himself, will He, since He says, 'Where I'm going, you cannot come'?" 23 "You are from below," He told them, "I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. 24 Therefore I told you that you will die in your sins. For if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."] JESUS tells them point blank that they would "die in their sin" and then in verse 24 HE tells them again that they will "die in their sins." Not to confuse anyone, but the singular used in verse 21, JESUS declares that they will die in their "sin" which is due to their unbelief as clearly stated by JESUS in **John 3:18** [Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.]

Next, in verse 24 JESUS states twice that they would "die in their sins" which is the many transgressions that they had committed and as John the Baptist call them "brood of vipers" because they would not confess their sins and they were unrepentant of those sins. In fact, they were challenging JESUS at every miracle and at every declaration of HIS LORDSHIP, HIS KINGSHIP and HE being sent from THE FATHER. It seems almost impossible for the religious leaders to turn their backs on the very SON OF GOD and then carry out the evil plan to have HIM nailed to the cross. But folks, it sure seems that the same problem that folks had then, is still here. Men, women, boys and girls, cowboys and cowgirls, are not recognizing the MESSIAH, they are turning their backs on the SAVIOR and LORD. They are even challenging HIM in their talk, their walk and their evil actions this very day, even in this supposed "one nation under GOD." Is it pride? Is it blindness? Or is it uncaring and unknowing? Whatever it is, it is time to seek HIM! It is time to confess! It is time to repent! It is time to accept JESUS CHRIST as your SAVIOR and LORD, because they did not know the SAVIOR had arrived and we do not know when HE will return and it could be soon. Are you ready? Drop to your knees and repent of your sins and confess that JESUS CHRIST is LORD. And do it today.

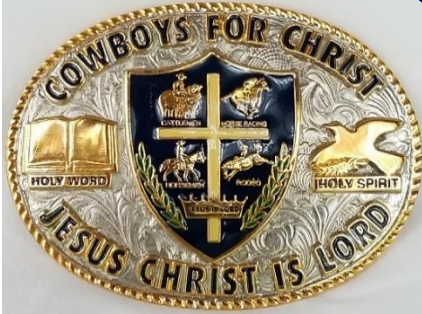

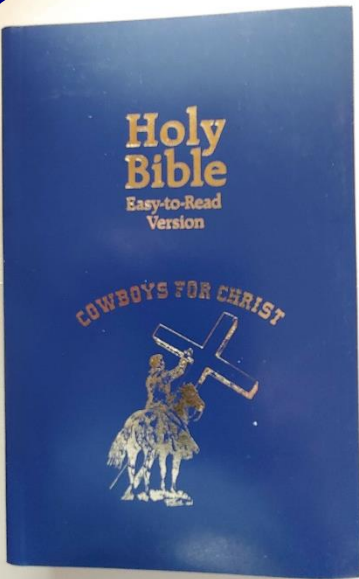

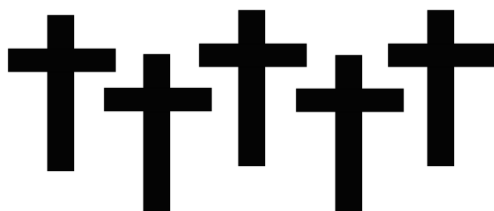
