
Greetings, I just read your "Christian Ranchman" front to back. I've got to say, I enjoyed it a lot. Let me give you a short version of my testimony. I came from a broken home. My father was murdered when I was 7 years old, a drug deal gone wrong. My mother was an alcoholic/drug addict and my step-father was an abusive workaholic. My uncle was a biker like my dad and he was a meth dealer, so following their lead, a young boy as I was, I just got hooked. I followed my uncle around, wanted to be like him, because he was like my real dad. I hated my step-dad and mom.

After I turned 13, I ran away for the first time, to my uncle's house in Banning California. I began stealing cars and

helping cook meth. I met a girl older than me by 12 years when I turned 17, we had kids and married. Back to Texas, selling meth for my uncle here in Burger Texas. At 20 I robbed a store and a preacher was beaten and left for dead. I got busted for this and got 7 years' probation. It lasted one year and I got busted for delivering manufacturing, and possession, which revoked my probation and I got sentenced to 55 years aggravated and have to serve 27 1/2 years before I'm eligible for parole. I've done 22 1/2 of those years.

I came into prison a gang member, mad at the world and God. But, through KAIROS and Trinity Fellowship Church in Amarillo, and Pastor Larry Miles, I began to change and it was not an easy road. I ended up in administration segregation for gang activity. After 4 years in solitary confinement, I gave up the gang life and became a Christian. I renounced my membership and began Bible Studies, got out of seg, got baptized, went through a faith-based program and I'm working on an Associate Degree in Pastoral Ministry through ICCS.

I come up for parole in 2027 for the first time. I plan on becoming a Chaplain myself in hopes to come back in to help minister to the younger generation. The youngsters coming in are taking over the system and they seem more lost that I was. But, if no one tries to reach them, they'll leave this place worse than what they came in as; that's a fact. I counsel the best I can now, but they'll listen more to someone in free-world clothes, than someone wearing white. Don't get me wrong, I've helped a few and will help some more, I'm sure. But volunteers are scarce these days. So, there's my story in a nutshell. I hope to get on your mailing list to receive the Christian Ranchman. God bless you and your ministry. Donald

Hello, my name is Juan Navarro and I am an inmate at Pekin Federal Correction Institute at Pekin Illinois and I have finished the three Bible studies. ## A Horse with a Heart

I don't know if you have ever heard a barrel racing champion, a cutting horse champion, or a reigning champion, or any other equine event champion being interviewed. After winning а championship a rider will most of the time want to give the credit to their horses. Usually they'll say something like "My horse has so much heart" or "my horse gives me all of its heart." "Without this horse giving me all that it has we wouldn't be champions." Everyone wants a horse with heart. What is the definition of a horse with heart? I think that the definition of a horse with heart is a horse that may not have the greatest confirmation, or it may not have the greatest blood-lines. However, it wins more, achieves more, and it goes beyond every one's expectations. A horse with heart does more things well, and goes above, and beyond then it should be able to. It reaches deeper, and gives more than it should have within itself to give. It has the capacity to know what you want. It loves its job and it loves to please. A horse with heart may even seem depressed or sad if it thinks that it has let you down. Horses with heart are hard to find. They don't come up for sale very often because if someone has one, they don't sale them. If they do sell them, then they don't know what they have or haven't been able to make that connection with their horse. You have to be careful with a horse with heart because sometimes it's hard to tell if they are hurt or injured. Most of the time they will go on in spite of pain or injury.

There isn't any magic wand you can wave to get a horse to give you, its heart. You just have to take the time that it takes to build that relationship with the horse. It may happen and it may not. Not every horse will be willing to give a rider or owner everything that it has. There's no button you can push. There's no trick to make a horse give you, its heart.

The horse just has to want to have that partnership with you. If you ever find or have a horse with heart then you will be way ahead of any competitor you may face in whatever event that you are competing in. This kind of horse will help you achieve more then you ever would be able to without one. You could go to the greatest barrel racing, cutting horse, reigning horse clinics, or train with the worlds best trainers. But if our horses are not willing to make that commitment to us, we'll never be as great as we could be with one that will.

Now I'm not writing this today to help you find a horse with heart or give you clues on what to look for in a horse to know if it is a horse that has heart. Nor am I writing this to give you ideas on how to get your horse to give you it's heart, to tell you anything about training your horse, or how to work on building your relationship with your horse. I'm writing this to tell you that Jesus is wanting you to give your heart to Him. Just like we all want a horse with heart, He wants our hearts. He wants disciples with heart or disciples that will give Him all their hearts. Without us giving Him our hearts, we will never achieve all that God has planned for us. We will never reach the goals that He has for us. There are no championships in and for the kingdom of God in our future without us giving our hearts completely to Him. There has to be a giving of all that we are to Him. A willingness to trust Him and giving our all when He cues us in life and ministry. Jesus doesn't make us give Him our hearts. He doesn't have a magic wand to wave over us. He leaves it up to each of us to whether or not we will give our hearts to Him. He can't and won't make us have that partnership with him that it takes to be champions in God's kingdom. Jesus said in Revelation 3:20 "Behold, I stand at the door and knock if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come into him and dine with him, and he with Me." You may say, "I have opened the door of my heart to Jesus and let Him in." Maybe you have

invited Jesus in as Lord and Savior. If you have, then you are saved and you are going to go to heaven when your life is over or when the rapture happens and He comes for His church.

But have you giving Him ALL of your heart? Have you given Him complete control of your reins? Are you willing to let Him direct you anywhere He wants you to go? And do whatever He has called you to do? Are you giving into the call that He has put on your life? Or do you still pull the reins out of His hands sometimes like an unbroken horse? Do you give to His guiding cues that are in His word and to the voice of the Holy Spirit within you? Does your relationship with Jesus fit the description of someone who has given their whole heart to Him like the description of a horse that has given their heart to its rider?

Every horse that competes is broke, rideable, and has gone through training. Just like everyone who has opened the door of their heart, has let Jesus in is saved, and ready for heaven. A lot of horses are capable of being really good at their event, but not every horse that competes will ever become a champion in their event that they have trained for and competed in. Every rider has to cue their horse to be able to direct them in what they need them to do. Most of them will give to their rider cues, but only a horse with heart, or a horse that gives its all to its rider, are the ones that reach their highest goals and achieves more than they ever could without giving their all to their rider. Those kinds of horses become champions most often in competitions because they hold nothing back. They give all they have to give. Just like a horse needs to trust its rider before it can give its all to them.

We as Jesus disciples need to trust Him completely with our lives. We need to be willing to hold nothing back from Him. Jesus has done everything that He can do to make you trust Him, but you have to decide for yourself that you will trust Him and give Him all our heart. Let Him have the reins of your life and He will lead you in being a champion for His kingdom.

Without giving the Lord all our hearts, we will never be able the reach the heights that He wants us to reach because we can't do it without Him taking the reins of our lives and guiding us where He wants us to go. God knows what it takes to make us champions for His kingdom. He's been making them since the beginning of creation. He knows what it takes to win those gold buckles in life. He is worthy of all that we can give Him and He deserves all that we can do for Him. He gave His all for us. We should give our all to Him. Don't hold anything back just give your whole heart, and life to Him, and He will guide you in His plan for being a championship for His kingdom. II Chronicles 16:9 says "The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him." Commit your heart fully to Jesus and you will find His strength rise up in you against every and all competitors in life. His strength will be yours for every event and every challenge that we face.

If you haven't yet opened the door to your heart and invited Jesus in to be the Lord of your life then that is where you need to start. Jesus is the only one who can make us world champions in and for the Kingdom of God. It's Jesus who is the only way into a relationship with the Father God. Jesus said in John 14:6 "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." # Riding Point With Dave Harvey...



**Rev 2:4** Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love.

They had forsaken, left, abandoned or cast aside their FIRST LOVE! As we search this word in the Greek aphiemi (af-ee'-ay-mee); (to send; or to send forth, and in various applications (as follow): KJV-hast left, CSB-abandoned, NIV-forsaken (which I am using) because it fits the narrative much better and give us a better picture of the TRUTH which we need to understand) NAS-have left, but I think you get the picture. It seems odd

that the KJV gives a number of meanings for this Greek word (cry, forgive, forsake, lay aside, leave, let (alone, be, go, have), omit, put (send) away, remit, suffer, yield up) but they did not use any of those words in this verse. It is so interesting to seek out the words that are the point word or words to a verse and research the meanings and the uses in the different translations. This study will bring a much clearer understanding to the verse, as well as the teaching that is so very important to our daily walk in the sinful world as children of the HOLY GOD. The deeper we dig, the more nuggets of pure TRUTH we will receive from our LORD and the HOLY SPIRIT through HIS HOLY WORD.

The next word or in this case words, that sure stands out and needs further research is "first love" and first is protos (pro'-tos); which means foremost (in time, place, order or importance): and is usually translated before, beginning, best, chief (est), first (of all), and for love it is agape (ag-ah'-pay); love, affection or benevolence; a love-feast: charity, dear, love. So, "their first love" had been forsaken, left on the trail of life, or abandoned and this sure confirms the teaching of JESUS as HE tells us in "Matt 24:12 Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold," and the same Greek word for love is used in both verses.

So, we now know that the "first love" of the church, the body of believers at Ephesus had not only grown cold, but had actually been forsaken, left behind, discarded or thrown away. This body of believers had forgotten why they were where they were as children of GOD. They had forgotten the LOVE of GOD THE FATHER, they have forgotten the LOVE of the SON, and in doing so they had lost the loving power of the HOLY SPIRIT. They had forsaken the TRUTH of the GOOD NEWS OF JESUS CHRIST and were working on religion instead of SPIRITUAL growth. They had lost the strength of the POWER OF GOD'S LOVE and most importantly they had forsaken their love for their LORD and SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST.

But let's back up a little and get an understanding of the setting of this wonderful Book of Revelation and focus on the TRUTH from our LORD as the Apostle John witnessed this powerful message from JESUS CHRIST on the Island of Patmos. John describes in detail his vision and the WORDS spoken for him to record so that we could study them and live by them from that day forth in Biblical history. The entire Book of Revelation is an up-to-date description of the events and happenings of the "last days" of life as we know it on this earth. And our LORD has a message for the world, HIS believers, and especially the Body of believers known as the seven New Testament Churches, which in turn would be all believers. The TRUTHS are there for us to understand and know and live by.

JESUS CHRIST started off with the strongest and most active group; the church at Ephesus. In fact, this group of believers was known as the greatest New Testament church of that era. As well as, a model group of believers and it should have been, because the Apostle Paul started this church and spent almost three years there during his ministry. And he then instilled his understudy, the young Timothy to be the pastor in his later years of ministry. And the Apostle John himself, also serve as the pastor of this flock for a time in his life, which was before he was exiled to Patmos. We are introduced to this church and the details of this church by the LORD in "Rev 2:1-3" To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: These are the words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands: 2 I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked men, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. 3 You have persevered and have endured

hardships for my name, and have not grown weary." The LORD starts off by commending this group of believers and telling them that HE knows of their "deeds, your hard work and your perseverance" and that they were strong in their stand against wickedness and false teachers. HE also commends them for enduring hardships, percussion and remaining faithful to HIS NAME.

But all of these good points seem to fade in the background as the LORD exposes their inward weakness and indifference. They had put on a good show to the locals, but they had certainly not fooled THE MASTER of their souls. HE came right out and declared them guilty of forgetting why they were even there as a part of the BODY of believers of JESUS CHRIST. They had forgotten the TRUTHS of the very things that the Apostle Paul had commended another Body of believers of which I have added my emphasized on the focus that he addressed in "1 Thess 1:3 We continually remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith (in our LORD JESUS CHRIST), your labor prompted by love (in our LORD JESUS CHRIST), and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. But the church at Ephesus was doing the work, the religious acts, but they had forgotten the LORD JESUS CHRIST, because HE is the reason for it all, and should have been foremost in their hearts, minds and souls.

It seems that many religious groups today have "forsaken their first love" too. You may have seen this posted around "I love my church" and I have seen this sign in yards and on car window or bumper sticker a number of times and I feel that they have missed the main point, too. The proper wording should be; "I LOVE MY LORD" and I enjoy being in the body of believers that HE has blessed me to be a part of. Cowboys and cowgirls, we need to get serious about our walk with the LORD JESUS CHRIST and especially about our love for the HIM. We need to be more like the great king David, as he states in "Ps 18:11 love you, O Lord, my strength." And we need to seek *(Continued Page 9)*

Our love for JESUS CHRIST should be the major influence in every decision that we make in our lives. Our love for our LORD should be the motivating factor in all of our ministry works to HIM. Our love for our KING should set the standard of every personal commitment and every public declaration in all that we say, do or plan in our lives. GOD bless you as you proclaim your "first love" to your LORD, In JESUS' NAME, Amen.

Unfortunately, behind prison walls, there are no cameras or phones allowed, so the treasured images get tucked away in my mind, and also in my heart. So, I will do my best, to describe to you, just one of these many precious moments that I have as a prison Chaplain.

Every Tuesday night I enter a world of regrets and sadness, a world where you are no longer in charge of your life, a world where only God sends hope. I hold a church service for the women, where we worship, pray and learn about the Lord. I love seeing the raw emotions these inmates display and the surprising honesty, considering they are in jail. The experiences that God has shared with me are numerous, but one night in particular stands apart from the rest. It was a CFC Bible Study Graduation Night. Numerous girls had completed their books, so I had brought in cupcakes, cookies and lemonade to celebrate.



There is one important decision that each and every person must make some time in their life. The decision to accept JESUS CHRIST as your LORD and SAVIOR guarantees eternal life. No one knows when their life will end, so it is very important to make that decision before it is too late.

The Bible very plainly tells us in Romans 3:23, "For all have sinned". Also, in Romans 6:23 we are told, "For the wages of sin is death". This death actually is referring to eternal death. These nights are a blessing and the ladies love them. We were singing 'Thy Will Be Done' and one particular lady started worshiping with all she had within her. The Holy Spirit was leading this night and all of a sudden Rochelle, (not her real name) moved to the center of our group. She went from crying, to laughing, to yelling, to jumping, to dancing.... all the time declaring to the Lord, 'Thy will be done.' Meanwhile I was quietly worshiping but also checking that the other ladies were coping with this uninhibited display of worship. Someone mentioned the presence of the Holy Spirit and tears started to fall. After the song had finished and we all sat down, I thought it best that we eat our cupcakes and start the graduation ceremony.
