Don't Pull Back

When I, or anyone else who rides horses, the one thing that you don't want to be doing is pulling back on the reins all the time! If we are good at riding horses, our goal is to train



a horse to ride without us having to ever pull on the reins when we ride them. As riders we want to guide a horse not pull on them.

You may say, "How do I get my horse to stop if I don't pull back on the reins?" The answer is to stop riding and your horse should come to a stop when you stop riding it. What do I mean when I say to stop riding your horse? When you ride you come up to the riding position, then you're moving with your horse, your body is in motion while you are riding, your hands are forward, your pelvis is moving with your horses' movements, and you're riding, and not just setting on your horse. So, when you stop doing all of that then that is the cue for your horse to stop and the horse will respond by stopping.

How many times have you seen a rider asking their horse to go forward over an obstacle, down a slope, or into water, and the rider is asking the horse to go forward while pulling back on the reins at the same time? We know that doesn't work for the horse as a good cue to go forward. That only leads to frustration and confusion for the horse, but I see that happen all the time. Most of the time the rider doesn't have any idea that they are pulling back; it's a subconscious decision. What's happening is that the rider is wanting the horse to go forward while inwardly they are nervous or anxious about what the horse may do while going forward over, though, or into the obstacle. They are usually unsure and think that when they release the reins the horse may go too fast for their comfort level. So, without realizing it, while asking the horse to go forward, they are also pulling back on the reins and telling the horse not to go forward. It's like holding

your foot on the brake pedal while pushing the gas pedal at the same time when you're driving a car; it's not the correct way to drive.

To help a rider that does this, most of the time, it takes someone else to point it out to them before they realize what they are doing. After the rider becomes aware that they are pulling back while asking the horse to go forward they can begin to work on why they are doing it. I think that all riders understand that pulling back on a horse while asking them to go forward is not the correct way to ride your horse. So, after seeing that a rider is doing that then they can deal with the reason they are pulling back while asking them to go forward. Once the rider sees what they are doing then they can work on making the change in their riding habits.

I find that most of the time it's a fear of what the horse's reaction is going to be when they ask their horse to go forward, over, or into the obstacle. As riders, we need to learn to stop pulling on our horses and just guide them in the direction that we want them to go. We guide a horse with our hands sometimes, also with our legs, and with our seat. Looking where you want to go is another way. Most of the time it's all of that combined. But we want to stay away from pulling on them. Pulling on our horses can and does create resistance in our horses. Pulling on them closes the door that we are asking them to go through when we want them to go forward. Riders need to keep the door open that they are asking their horses to go through. The way that we keep the door open is by taking away any pressure that would stop them from going in the direction that we want them to go. Take pressure off from going forward by putting your hands forward and taking all the pressure out of the horse's mouth. That will open the door for them to go forward.

Don't Pull Back Continued

Our walk with the Lord is similar to horseback riding in that we shouldn't be pulling back from God as we are trying to walk with Him and go forward in our relationship with Him. If we want to walk with God in life, we need to follow His direction that we get from His Word. We need to become doers of the Word, and not just hearers only as it says in James 1:22. We need to follow the Holy Spirit's guiding cues in life. But if we are pulling back from God, and pulling back from our faith in God, while we say that we want God's will to be done in our lives then we are like the rider who is asking their horse to go forward while pulling back on the reins at the same time. To be successful in our walk with God we need to stop wavering in our faith and trust God with all of our hearts. Trust that He is who He says He is, and He will do what He says that He will do. Hebrews 10:38 -39 "Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him. 39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul." As believers we want to make sure that we are pressing on toward God's will in our lives. God's will for His children is for them to put their complete faith in Him and His promises. We need to be believing God more and more for the things that He has promised us in His word. We need to be growing in our faith in God and not pulling back (drawing back) in our faith. God has proved Himself faithful throughout history as you can see when you read the Bible. If you spend any time at all in the Word, then you know that He is always faithful to help and answer our prayers when believers call unto Him. He has made a way for our victory in life though His Son Jesus. Our faith in Him isn't built on empty promises. What God has promised will come to pass no matter what things look like in life or what your senses are telling you. You can be sure that God has got you and He will be faithful to His promises, no matter what life brings.

Pulling back from God isn't the answer. Pulling back from God, or our faith in Him, is the

wrong thing to do to get the rewards of faith. As Christians it should be our life's goal to please God. According to verse 38 in Hebrews 10 God has no pleasure in those who "draw back" (pull back) from their faith. But if we are pulling back from our faith then we are not pleasing Him. The Bible also says in Hebrews 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those diligently seek Him." Just like Abraham's faith in God brought God's rewards in his life, it's our faith in God that brings God's rewards in our lives. Be a Christian like the one described in vs.39. Don't be one who draws back, but one who believes to the saving of the soul. That means believing to the end, never pulling back, or never giving up on your faith in God. Don't be a rider that pulls back and don't be a believer that pulls back from your faith.

As a horse trainer and preacher, I don't want to just point out the problems. It's my duty to give people the answer to the problems or difficulties they face. So how can we become Christians that don't pull back? I can make a couple of suggestions. Faith works a lot like our muscles. To grow muscles, we have to feed them and exercise for them to grow. The same thing is true for our faith. We need to feed it, and exercise our faith, and it will grow. To feed our faith we need to spend time in the Bible because it's the Word that is food to our faith and we need to exercise our faith by using our faith. Using, or exercising our faith by applying resistance to it, builds it up. Just like when you are trying to build muscle mass you apply resistance to the muscle by lifting weights and that builds muscles. The same thing is true in building faith. When you apply resistance to your faith it becomes stronger over time and it grows. Romans 10:17 "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." If faith comes by hearing God's Word, then the way to strengthen our faith is hearing more of His Word. Spending time in the Word will feed your faith. We can hear more by listening to more preaching of the Word. There's all kind of ways to hear more of the Word in this day of technology. We can

exercise our faith by standing on the promises of God and seeing God do what He said that He would do. As we grow stronger in our faith, we will have less tendency to pull back from our faith as we go through life. We will be more willing to put our hands forward as we ride through life with Him. Let's trust God to take us forward through every obstacle and hazard that comes our way in life.

As riders, do yourself a favor and focus on not pulling on your horses as you ride. Try to just guide your horse with a bump, with a squeeze, and with your body position. And as believers, try to build your faith so that you will not draw back from it as you face opposition. That will give you the strength to remain faithful in this ride through life. As you come up against obstacles and hazards in life just remember to put your hands forward, give God all the reins, and don't pull back.

from Henry Gauna

Greetings, I am Henry Gauna and I have been in a TDCJ prison for 19 years and I have been transferred here to the Telford Unit. Another prisoner had given me the Christian Ranchman. I never seen such publish newspaper. But as I read your Ranchman, it opened my eyes and heart. There were so many testimonies, and I like the way everyone uses their land/ranches for gatherings for all Christ followers. Your Christian Ranchman is very inspiring, because I read everything with an open mind and heart. There is a verse in the Bible that I like so much; Proverbs 3:5-6. Back when I was 19 years old, I had given my heart, soul to our Lord Jesus Christ. Believe me I am not much to commit, but that day when I released myself, my heart and I don't do that for no one, I felt a small and I mean a very small feeling in my back, broken and the spreading through my whole body. I was scared to receive such feeling and I didn't know what it was. But I was feeling so very light, like something just washed from me and that day I was not the person I was. I had moved out of my parents' house and live with one of the church members. God was bringing me so much; I just couldn't believe it. But ever since then I had trusted in the Lord Jesus.

But please believe me that Satan was there, he knows my addictions and was placing them in front of me. But I always prayed, Lord I trust in you. And then one day at the meeting something happened to me. I jumped up and was saying, what about me, and yelling and using profane words. I then told one of my best friends, who introduced me to the church to take me back to my parents. I had this anger and just like that "quickly" I lost my way and then my life got 10 times worser. At the age of 24 years old I came to prison for 9 years and went home. But through those 9 years I try to get back my grace, but I've seen so much violence and my sex addiction was kicking in so very badly that I went home and used women and young girls to fill my addiction. I didn't care who I hurt. And then at the age

of 37 or 39 I came back to prison for life.

I've been to prison church and took Christian classes, but I couldn't commit, my heart was closed and felt that Satan had his hands around my heart and not wanting to let go this time. Ever since then my life has been going through hell, and then while being locked up constantly alone. Then I received the Christian Ranchman paper and I didn't have much to read as my property was taken from me. So, I was reading everything that came to me by other prisoners. So, when this prisoner pushed the paper through a crack in the wall. I kept it and read every word in it. Believe me all I wanted is to see the women and young girls. But when I read the paper, I was blinded and just saw the words. I read the paper over and over and I had tears falling from my eyes. My heart was hurting, so bad. Satan was squeezing very tightly and would not let go. I then prayed and ask the Lord to please forgive and take me back. I didn't feel what I felt when I was 19 years old, but I continued to pray.

I still can't feel the grace I use to have, but because of your Christian Ranchman paper it opens something inside of me. I don't read my Bible, but it's here with me. I still pray off and on but no commitment, but I am trying. Whoever reads this, please let me inform you, the devil is for real and we have to acknowledge God every day, every minute and second of our lives, because Satan is there waiting for you to crack, fall, slide back. Your mind, heart, soul has to be for God and we must trust in the Lord with all our hearts, Proverbs 3:5-6.

What I had was very beautiful, I was happy, full of caring, love and wanted everyone to feel what I felt, but be very careful. I am still alive inside, but hurting so much. I'm fighting every day, one day I will have that grace in my life again. I thank the Lord for the Christian Ranchman paper. I want to receive more if I may. Your words and testimonies are so very inspiring. I still have family who visits me, and some friends, but I am still alone. I'm 58 years old now. I still praying one day the Lord will forgive me and take me back into His arms. Mr. Dave Harvey, I

sincerely pray for you and all your members and thanks for sharing the Word of God. If you please, put me on your mailing list and if I may receive the ERV Bible. I'm kind of blind and can't see well. So, if I may receive a large print, thank you, In His Name, Henry (Editor's note: Henry was sent the Bible.)

I had just got off the school bus and walked into my home and everything changed. My dad had a guy held with a knife to his throat and my mother was screaming, "don't Dale." I would soon find out that this guy was my mothers' boyfriend. My dad had come home early from work to a surprise. Over the next few days mom left with her boyfriend and my brother. My dad was drunk and in shock. He told me that he needed time to get some things straight and to find a place to live. So, I was going to live with my grandfather in Missouri. Soon we where on a road trip that would truly change the course of my life.

When I got to my grandfather's house things were much different than my home. My grandfather had married a younger women with several children around my age. Things where much slower paced. No drinking, smoking, fighting, cursing, unexpected visitors. One thing seemed to be real important; God. They mentioned him a lot, and not the way I had heard his name used before. 

Pecking Order

All of us who own horses are well aware of the concept of "Pecking Order". The Oxford Dictionary defines pecking order as: "a hierarchy of status seen among members of a group of people or animals, originally observed among hens." Horses are a great example of this as well. We've all seen a dominant horse having its choice of hay, or being first at the water trough, or first into the barn at feeding time. I once had a gelding that not only set himself up as dominant, but he also determined who would be second, third and fourth. In the pasture, he was in charge. The last thing any of us wants, however, is a horse that believes he is dominant over us in the barn or anywhere else. If that situation develops, drastic action must be taken. In Genesis 1:25-28 God creates mankind, blesses them and tells them, "Be fruitful... fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish...the birds...and every living creature that moves on the ground." God placed mankind at the top of the "Pecking Order" here on earth. However, in Genesis 3:1-6 the serpent had a conversation with Eve and convinced her to eat the fruit which was forbidden to them. Verse 6 ends by saying, "She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it."

Jonah 1:1-3 Now the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

A world full of Jonahs! That is what we have today. 



Testimony

It is not easy to write down things about ourselves, but the impact that one's story can have on other people is what Christianity is all about. I grew up in a small country town and attended church on a regular basis, yet like most people found myself far from God. I thought of myself as a pretty good dude and felt like I would do the right thing in most situations, if given the chance. However, I fell in love with something that changed my life, call crystal meth. It took everything from me and I surrendered all I was to her. She became my all in all. I took off in the other direction from God, following the hoot owl trail and hanging out with the wrong kinds of people. Thinking myself some kind of outlaw and dependent on crystal meth to lead me to do things that caused society to deem me unworthy of being able to be free. Every time I got locked up, I would read my Bible and do studies, however when I go out, I would run right back to crystal. Then something happened that changed my whole life.

On October 31, 2008 when I was strung out and on the run from the law, they busted me. Upon my incarceration I was not crying out to God for help nor did I feel anything. I looked like a walking dead man. If there was ever someone who was a dead branch on a tree, it was me. No doubt there was not any reason I should even be alive. Sitting in a cell not knowing or caring what would happen to me; okay, with whatever came my way. Someone banged on the cell door and looked through this small window in the cell. For the first time in my life, I think nothing mattered to me so when I looked up and saw the county jail Chaplain Sonny Buckingham.

He smiled at me and asked me, "how you doing cowboy?" I looked at him with a stone face as he asked me, "What happened?" I told him don't forget you are also a deputy sheriff. He laughed and asked me if he could pray for me. He did pray for me and the next morning I woke up and there was a Bible on the floor where someone had put it under the door. It was the Bible my Nanny gave me when I had got locked up the first time. Inside the cover she had wrote read Daniel chapter 3. So, I did and then every morning when I woke up there was a Bible study there and a note from Mrs. Shirley, a volunteer in the church, saying draw closer to God and He will draw closer to you. She told me she was praying for me and that God loved me so much that He gave his only begotten Son so that whosoever believed in Him would not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16). From that day that Sonny prayed for me I saw myself for the sinner that I am and God gave me a hunger for Him that has never left me still today. When I was not looking for God, He found me and I returned to Him with a repented heart where He welcomed me with open arms. My Mon's sister saw me on the news for what I was inside for and she came up there with my mom to visit me. God placed so many angels to help disciple me, it is not even funny. My Aunt Rosa helped teach me and love me through one of the toughest times in my life, showing me the love of God that my folks could never do and in doing so she walked me through the Bible, answering all questions and directing me to let go and let God.

I got my time and came to prison but I was not the same person I was before. God was transforming me and molding me into a Kingdom man for His Kingdom. I did every Bible study and read the Bible through and through. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things are passed away; behold, new things have come.

Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them and He was committed to us the word of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us, we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:17-21)

The Bible equipped me and developed me as God dusted me off, making me His masterpiece. After seven years of being incarcerated God told me it was time to go hit the streets and go into those places that no man wanted to go to speak about the Good News. So, I left the hoot owl trail and turned over a new leaf. In 2014 I started a church service in the day room of one of the roughest prisons in Texas where I saw men give their lives to Jesus. I got shipped from there continuing to serve God with all my heart. One day an event that has propelled me to new heights occurred as I was sitting at work. The Chaplain called my boss telling him for me to report to the Chapel. We all know that is not good news inside these walls. Yet, that day after praying with my boss I went there, and he told me that Huntsville had recommended me for a Bible college that had been started in prison for men who had a lot of time. I had been praying and asking God what would be next in my life. So, I got an application and went to the wing to call my Aunt to discuss my next move. She told me it was answered prayer, so I filled it out and trusted God to do the rest. In 2020 I graduated with a bachelor degree from Southwest Baptist Theological Seminary. I have preached many sermons, baptized men in the Name of Jesus and evangelized all of the prison system. Currently I get on my horse and go down paths no one else would dare to tell the worse guys in prison about the toughest

man I ever met, Jesus Christ. That's even when you're are not looking for Him, He is looking for you.

It was a bright and sunny day for a picnic and I was hanging around with a group of friends. Everyone in the group was congratulating me for making it to retirement. Whenever someone retires, they are usually asked questions such as,

But when it came to the question of what I was doing next in my life, I let everyone know that I wasn't quite sure yet. God had placed me as a teacher in the Reynolds School District and I stayed there for 34 years until God said I was released to retire. But I hadn't heard from God on what I should do next in my life. Well, not exactly. When I prayed for guidance on what to do next, the answer would come back, "Share". Share what? My land, my horses, my motorhome, the Gospel, the Good News, my money, my knowledge of 35 years of teaching? I just didn't hear a clear answer. I did however feel very free, as if I was on vacation for a while. I had had a very stressful career in teaching working with the most difficult of children. For 27 years I taught with God's help, the students with anger, behavior problems, demon possession, emotional issues, as well as learning problems. I spent the last 8 years as a teacher in the position of assistant principal. 

and she readily joined me. My parents never stressed us going to church because they were not the church going type, though confess to be believers. Well, that day God called me and I got up and walked out of the service. That day my baby sister accepted what I walked away from. I thought that trying to be a Christian would distance me from my fun, besides I had it going on; so, I thought.

I went to college, started messing with drugs, suffered a bad injury, which derailed my NFL career. I did more drugs to cope with my failures and disappointments. And then I stated stealing, lying, deceiving and distanced myself from my friends; instead opted for associates. To make a long story short, I ended up taking a man's life while high and seeking more money for drugs. Now I sit with a life sentence.

Yet, in the midst of it all, God never gave up on me. At my rock-bottom, brick wall; God called to me, letting me know that through I forsook and ran from Him, He never left my side nor stopped wooing me. He sent a Christian from another town opposite where I am from to come visit me at the county jail with a message. God said, "He loved me and had a specific purpose for me." I ended up accepting Jesus as Lord and Savior because of that obedient man, Jack McClain, who has since gone to the Father. He even baptized me at the county jail in a watering trough/tank.

Through the pathway hasn't been a bed of roses, I've stayed the course, serving God. That day at county was the greatest decision of my life, and I am joyous that I did not walk away from God that time. The person I was is no more! My life is in Christ and Christ's.


