I Shall Not Die But Live by Karla Welch

"I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord." Ps. 118:17 It was great weather, and we decided to head to our favorite place, Otter Creek Horse Trail System located in the Adirondack's in Upstate New York. We arrived Wednesday, and planned on riding with two friends, Lori and Lynn, for several days. On Sunday, we rode to one of our favorite places, ate lunch and started heading back to camp. I was riding Roger's horse, Denver, because I was video taping my horse, Max, which he was riding, getting ready to sell him. Denver is what you call a "buddy sour horse," meaning he does not like to be too far behind or out of sight of his buddy, Max. Roger was leading on Max and our two friends were behind me. We were moving right along in a nice trail gait, which would be a "trot" on a nongaited horse. We got to a section of the trail where it goes down into a gully and back up. I "checked" Denver attempting to slow him down. This upset him as he wanted to keep up with Max, and he took a few steps off the trail. The last thing I remember is seeing Roger heading back up the other side of the gully as I looked down at some

roots on the right side of Denver. All of a sudden Denver started rearing up and continued straight up, and I said, "Oh Lord, I think he's going to come right over on me. I fell off and within two seconds Denver's completely airborne body landed on me with a big thud...all 1,000 pounds...crushing me. I'm not a big person...I'm small in stature, 5 ft. 3" and pushing 73 years "young." I told Lori, who was riding directly behind me, "I'm hurt really bad." She then told Lynn to ride ahead, where she could get cell service, and call for help. I thought my back was broken as I lie there in excruciating pain. Roger immediately rushed over to me and took my hand and started praying. I asked him to call our Pastor for prayer. I honestly didn't know what was going to happen and figured if I was going to die, I wanted prayer on the way out. I remember laying there whispering to my horse friend, Sally, who had moved to Heaven a year earlier, "Sally, I may be coming to join you" as my breathing was becoming shallower. Who knows what they can see or hear...the Bible says in Heb. 12:1 "We are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses." Roger told me he managed to call our Pastor, but he didn't answer so left a message...my heart sank. But immediately, Pastor called back,

and Roger put the phone to my ear and he prayed for me. As I lay there, I asked the Lord to forgive me of any unknown sins and to cleanse me...I wanted to be as prepared as possible if this was MY appointed time! Heb. 9:27 "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment."

Always remember up to your last breath, unless you die suddenly, it's never too late to repent and or call on the Name of the Lord to be saved. Like our Pastor says..."location, location"...make sure you're going to the right place. Jesus is alive, Heaven and Hell are real, and eternity is forever and ever. There are MANY miles of trails at Otter Creek and there just "happened" to be a family not too far behind us that arrived on the scene within minutes and wife was trained in trauma! Thank you, Lord!!! To make a long story short, I ended up being taken on a body board via ATV, ambulance to the rescue Helicopter which flew me to the Hospital. After tests, they found out I had broken four ribs, punctured lung, and a fractured sternum. I was in the hospital four days and discharged. Seven days later, while at home, I had shortness of breath along with extreme fatigue and was rushed

to a different hospital. I was given an MRI and it was determined I had a blood clot in each lung. I was told conflicting things by different doctors...one said no horse back riding until Spring when I would be totally healed. Another doctor told me December because when one has a traumatic injury. the longer you wait to resume what you were doing, the harder it's going to be. If I hadn't been seriously hurt when the horse reared, I would have immediately brushed myself off and gotten back on. But as the days went by, my anxiety grew when I thought about getting back on a horse...it was a form of PTSD...Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. I developed an overwhelming fear, to the point where I could have easily given up on horses and actually wanted to. In fact, I had contacted Camping World regarding trading our horse trailer in for a regular camper. Of course, Roger, wasn't in agreement and encouraged me to hold off giving up "living my dream of owning and riding horses" until at least Spring. I told him, "You can't make me get on a horse!!" I was told about another local lady that had a similar horse accident three days after mine. Her horse spooked; she was thrown and suffered broken ribs, punctured lung, fractured collarbone, fractured skull, brain bleed and a concussion. I'm very glad I had my helmet on...she was not wearing one. I'm sure my helmet prevented further injuries when my head hit the ground and also when Denver's head hit mine. I only ended up with a small goose egg instead of my skull possibly being split open. I started wearing a helmet years ago when I heard about a similar accident and hope those reading this will consider doing the same. It's a cheap price to pay for something that may save your life or you from brain injury. In November, three months after our accidents, she was still not doing well and has had brain surgery and was in therapy. On the other hand, my doctor "ordered" me to climb back on a horse.

A friend told me he was on a business flight and sitting next to a girl on her way to her mother's funeral...come to find out her mother's horse had flipped over on her...the

same exact thing that had happened to me... except it killed her! Sometimes Roger and I switch saddles when swapping horses. I know if I was riding in Roger's saddle, which has a horn, I would have been impaled and dead.

The week before Thanksgiving, we went to Tuesday morning prayer meeting at our church, and I was still suffering big time with the PTSD regarding riding a horse. They anointed with oil, laid hands on me and prayed the spirit of fear regarding getting on a horse would leave. When I woke up the next morning, I knew something had INDEED lifted...honestly, it was like night and day...unbelieveable! I came bounding downstairs and BOLDY announced to Roger that I WAS going to get on a horse, even "THE" horse if I had to. I was trying to make arrangements to ride a "safe" horse that a friend had offered and was determined that the next nice day I would do this.

The following Tuesday, right before Thanksgiving, the weather was mild and I decided that would be the day. It had been three months and one week since my accident. My friend's schedule didn't work out to get on her horse, so I decided it would have to be THE horse, Denver... the one that about killed me. Sometimes you have to face your greatest fear and actually for me, this was the best solution. I was still upset with Denver while brushing him before saddling and said, "If you do anything to hurt me, I'm going to get my pistol and put a bullet right between your eyes!" I think he heard that and believed it! Since he hadn't been ridden in three months, Roger rode him around our arena first and then I mounted. The amazing thing...there was not one ounce of apprehension...my heart wasn't beating out of my chest...I had absolutely NO fear riding him. Denver was excellent and it was just like the accident never happened; Not only did I get on "A" horse but rode the one I vowed to NEVER EVER ride again. Since then, I've taken him camping this past April and am now riding him by myself.

Il Timothy 1:7 "He has not given me the spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

I feel God saved my life twice within a two-week span...once during the accident and then again when I got the blood clots. AND He delivered me from the spirit of fear! My Pastor says, "I'm a walking miracle because I'm not dead." So, by the grace, goodness and faithfulness of God, I'm alive and can tell this story and "declare the works of the Lord." To God be the glory!! Letter and Testimony

Dear Cowboys For Christ, Thank you for the invitation to share my testimony of how God has worked in my life! God is good and His grace is always sufficient. I do not know how I got on your mailing list, but I consider it a gift and blessing from God to increase my territory (Jabez) from beyond these prison walls. I had been running from God for over 50 years. When I was a young boy, my mother told me, "You will be a preacher." Those words scared me to the core and I learned to live comfortably in the shadows hoping it would be enough to "just get by" keeping my distance from hearing God's call. I hid in the shadows of knowing the Bible, memorizing Scripture, attending church and Bible Study regularly, serving on the Praise and Worship team, leading the Men's ministry, and even helping start a new church. You know, "just enough' to fool everyone, having them say, "He's a good Christian!" As long as I stayed "BUSY" (Being Under Satan's Yoke) by doing "my own things" I wouldn't have to hear God's call for me to do "His thing." But like Jonah, God's plan unfolded in His time, and He allowed me to follow my own path which led me to prison in Kansas (I'm originally from Stephenville, Texas.) It was while in prison where I had to stop

running, "Be still, and know He is God." It opened up my eyes and I began to realize Matt 7:21 was written just for me. I realized I had been saying "Lord, Lord" didn't you see me do all these things just for You?" Being still, I finally heard, "Only those who do the will of My Father will enter the Kingdom of Heaven." The bottom of "my plans" fell out and I began to realize the difference between "my plans" and "His plans." You would think I would have gotten the hint escaping death once at the age of 6 and three times at age 14, but some need a bigger 2x4! What I did realize was every breath we take is a miracle, a gift from God, and His way of saying, "I am not done with you." I still kept running from His call. Thus, the Big Fish prison. Sometimes God allows bad things to happen to us to achieve His plan. God can turn any mess into His message! While many people may consider prison frightening and a loss of freedom, to me, it is the place where I have complete Joy, peace, and a place I have felt more freedom than ever before. Do not feel sorry for me, because.... "Phil 1:2 Now I want you to know, brothers and sister, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the Gospel." And as Joseph told his brothers, "You did not send me here, God did!" What has happened to me is a part of God's omniscient plan! Now through His grace, 1) I preach and teach the Gospel every day, 2) I have taught men to understand and believe that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life and no one comes to the Father except through Jesus, 3) The Gospel is being spread through my reports, newsletter, and personal letters to prisoners I do not even know through individuals, organizations and churches I write to, 4) Men are being taught how to walk

Yes, you may say, "Everyone finds religion in prison." Well, many people in the so-called "free world" only find religion as well. Like me, all I was doing was living as someone

with the Lord according to His ways, 5) Men

are learning the meaning of true obedience,

6) Men are becoming true disciples and

are reaching out to other men and are

learning how to share the Gospel to others.

And 7) Men are learning to be Christ-like.

who only found religion on the outside. It took prison for me to find Jesus! I went to church, I read the Bibe, I was involved in the church, I had memorized Scriptures, I wore a cross, and I had many Bibles. I did all that but now I realize calling yourself a Christian and even acting the part doesn't mean you are Christ-like. All it meant was that I was "comfortable" and that is where I failed. God isn't calling us to be "comfortable" He wants and desires for us to have a relationship with Him! We say we have a relationship with Him, and we say "we believe" but still we live with a bunch of "I can't." If we have the Holy Spirit within us, how can we have "I can't?" The same power of the Holy Spirit who was at creation and raised Jesus form the dead is the same exact Holy Spirit living inside all believers. If you believe this, then you have the power of the Holy Spirit to help you say, "I can do all things through Him who gives me strength!" Because of the Holv Spirit living inside of me, I can preach and teach. Not only to the men in this facility, but also through the assistance of supporting churches and individuals and other prisons ministries, God Word can reach beyond these fences and beyond any walls. Halleluiah! My ministry is called, "Every Breath Prison Ministries" and I have been spreading the Gospel for five years now. Through God's grace, I plan to continue spreading the Gospel once released to men in prison and to the ex-prisoners who do not feel or have not been welcomed in some churches. God has given me a clear path only because I finally quit running. I emptied myself and now I run full press onward to His calling, completely filled with His love, mercy, grace, and never-ending forgiveness. I wish I could tell you more about the wonderful things God has done for me. May the grace of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, the love of our Father in Heaven, and the strength and power of the Holy Spirit be with you and all your readers! Together in Christ, Andrew



Biblical Coins

He said, "I will hand Jesus over to you. What will you pay me for doing this? The priests gave him thirty silver coins" (Matthew 26:15). This is when Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus Christ. What type of silver pieces or coins were these? According to most Biblical scholars these were known as shekels of Tyre. Because they contained 94% silver content and were known in those days as the Temple Tax Coin. Therefore, they were the only accepted currency at the Temple in Jerusalem. In Matthew's original writings, before translation the word argyria- meaning silver coins was used.

Is there any hidden meaning in thirty pieces of silver? With a little investigation we find that this amount of silver shekels is the value of a slave. Further evidence of this can be found in Exodus 21:32, which states: "But if the bull kills the slave, the owner of the animal must pay the master 30 pieces of silver and the bull must also be stoned to death".

Where are the thirty silver coins that were traded for Jesus today? This is what we do know, after this betrayal Judas threw the coins back into the Temple and went off and hung himself. Only one of the original coins continued to bounce from history to the present. It is kept under lock and key in the treasury of the ancient parish church of Saint Asela, in the oldest Croatian town of Nin.

Although the thirty silver coins being ancient and rare would make their value priceless. However, their approximate value today, with the silver content would be around \$198.32. Can you believe that Jesus was betrayed in today's prices for under two-hundred bucks?

Being a Chaplain in Cowboys for Christ, I ask that you bow your head and take a moment and say: I am sorry dear Jesus that you were betrayed, I will work my hardest not to betray you. You are my Savior and Lord, and the Lamb of God. From this moment forward I will follow the Lamb wherever He may go. Amen!

TIME



2 Peter 3:8-9 8 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. 9 The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. Time; a minute, an hour, a day, a week, a month, a year or a thousand years, they are all the same to FATHER GOD. There is no difference, or limits or restrictions; all are the same. But we are not blessed with the same freedom, as we are living in a sinful world full of many limitations, many restrictions, and we are

certainly confined by every boundary of the reaches of time. Most carry a watch or some type of time device to help them keep on their daily schedule. I gave up wearing a watch a number of years ago, because it was always in my way and I was always very tough on the fragileness of a timepiece on my arm. Plus, since I always carrying my cell phone, I could check it for the time and even the date, as I would get so caught up in the many things that I needed to do, that I couldn't keep up with the time much less the date. It certainly is a fact; mankind is greatly affected by the restrictions of time.

The Apostle Peter was telling anyone reading this wonderful Book of second Peter that we must not put GOD in the same time restrains in which we are living. We must be very understanding of our limitations concerning time, but we must also be very understanding of the complete lack of any and all restraints upon the HOLY GOD. The Psalmist declared in **Ps 90:4** For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night. A thousand years are like our 24-hour day, or like a watch in the night. Actually, the Jewish nation had three watches during the night; sunset until midnight, midnight until 3am and 3am until sunrise, which varied according to the seasons. But after the captivity; as the Greeks and Romans separated the night into four watch sections; the time of the different watches was usually about two hours. So, we can surmise by this that a normal watch in Peter's time was about two hours, which means that a thousand years for our HOLY CREATOR have a consideration of about two hours. Now by that calculation and to give you a better understanding of time in GOD'S eyes, I will ask you; how old are you to FATHER GOD? This kind of give you an indication of why we are called the children of GOD, doesn't it?

Adam and Eve did not have a time restraint until the fall, as we are clearly taught that mankind was created to be a companion to the ETERNAL HOLY GOD. **Gen 1:26-27** 26 And God said, Let us make man in Our image, after Our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. 27 So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And since GOD is timeless, mankind was first created to be a timeless creation. But sin entered and the restrictions of time came along with sin, because death entered along with sin, which means that everything living is now constantly dying. "**Rom 5:12** Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned" and death means that we as sinful mankind are all eternal dying, except for JESUS CHRIST.

If I can get you to remember this, or reflect on this TRUTH every time you look at your watch, your clock or your phone to see what time it is, then you will be so much closer to understanding what the Apostle Peter is trying to teach us. He is telling each one of us the importance of knowing the time limitations on us because of sin and those limitations will always be there except for the BLOOD OF THE LAMB of GOD. As the only way to offset the dying, is with the living SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST. You are certainly dying and you will continue to die until your dying is completed at your death, or until the LORD comes back for HIS Church, HIS Body, HIS redeemed creation. That is if you are a child of GOD through the BLOOD OF THE LAMB OF GOD, JESUS CHRIST.

First, don't panic, don't try to run and hide; because you can't hide from death, but there is a solution to this dying. The answer is living; and that means living eternally just as you were created to do; you and all the rest of mankind. The HOLY GOD did not create you to die and as we are told in our text, HE is very patient with you to understand this time thing, this sin thing and repent of your sins and accept HIS GIFT of HIS ONLY SON, the BLOOD OF THE LAMB to wash away your sins and to be HIS child so you can be the eternal living being HE created you to be, for HIS glory, honor and to worship and serve HIM. HE is timeless, but you are not, or at least you are not if you haven't repented of your sins and your sinful ways and accepted JESUS CHRIST as your SAVIOR and LORD. You may be asking; well, how do I know that GOD really loves me? Well, because HE gave HIS SON to die on the cross (John 3:16) for your sins before you were born. Because HIS SON gave HIS LIFE on the cross even when HE knew you and your evil ways (Rom. 5:8) and because HIS HOLY WORD tells us the facts of eternal salvation. 



My Testimony Continued

Sunday afternoon, literally between Sunday morning service and Sunday evening service. Despite my mother's vision of me being a minister and despite being raised in the church, I was never the true child of God I needed to be. In complete honesty, I was always at the church, but I never was truly in the church. There is a difference. I could quote scripture, chapter and verse with the best of them. But knowing it and living it are two different things. Despite of all of my mother's prayers, despite all the time I had spent at the church, I was not spiritually where I needed to be. I was never in trouble. I never was one to drink and party, but that is not the measure God uses. I was just an empty vessel, wondering on my own. Because of the love I have for the equine and bovine industries, I went to West Texas A&M University in Canyon, Texas to study Animal Science. My hope, at least at the time, was to enroll in veterinarian school at Texas A&M following my time at WTAMU. College introduced me to a whole new world I had never seen before. As I said before, I was not spiritually where I needed to be at that point in my life. I was, however, sheltered from a lot of what happens in the world outside of the boundaries of my Christian home and the church. On my own for the first time, I entered a world without the protection of the armor of God or my parents shielding me from the vices and influences of life. Even though there was a church just a few blocks off campus, I rarely attended. Instead, I occupied my time with friends and student organizations. During this time, I strayed from my parents' raising and, in some ways, became the "typical" college student at WTAMU. Despite the "fun times", I knew in my heart I was not living the way I should. I attended the University's Baptist Student Union sporadically. In complete honesty, I initially went to their meetings for the free lunch they offered every Wednesday at noon. But, that would soon change. In what we see as a free meal, God uses as a means to soften the heart. Everything I thought was great and fun about college

life would soon come crashing down around me. In the second semester of my freshman year, at a time I felt completely broken. In a time of dispair, I met with the Director of the Baptist Student Ministry in his office. There, I finally accepted Christ. I was baptized in my home church with my mother witnessing. She had the biggest smile on her face. I returned home from WTAMU a changed man. Although I had intended on becoming a veterinarian, I began working as a police officer, in what I thought at the time to be a temporary means of employment. 27 years later, I'm still doing it. On July 25, 2007, God provided me the biggest need I had in my life, next to my relationship with Him. I met the lady who would become my wife. Tara has been described by many as a true angel. Prior to our meeting, she took it upon herself to adopt two children, biologically brother and sister. Following our marriage, I adopted both and accepted them as my own. Megan, who now 22, is a low functioning, non-verbal autistic. Brandon, now 21, is living on his own with two daughters of his own. We purchased a home and settled into what we thought would be our small family. God had different plans. Tara had been told by multiple doctors since her mid-teens she would never be able to have children of her own. However, we serve a God of miracles. Five months after our first anniversary, God blessed us with Kyle, who is now 13. Thinking Kyle was our one and only miracle baby, God gave us twin boys, Levi and Logan a little over a year later. All three have been baptized and are active in the church. On May 13th of 2012, following Sunday evening service, I was eating supper at a restaurant with my wife and parents. In what I would later realize was my last real conversation with my mother, she again reminded me of her vision that she felt I was called to the ministry. My wife joined in and agreed with my mother. Me, still running from any calling whatsoever, borrowed a line from our esteemed brother Billy Graham. I told her "two things I will never be is a preacher or an undertaker". As I should have learned early in life; never say never

when God is involved. That comedic remark did not work for Billy Graham and it did not work for me either. Little did I know at the time, but that would be the last time I got to talk with my mother. She passed from this life during a medical procedure the following day. One thing (out of many) I have learned from my mother's passing is our prayers are perpetual. Our loved ones may pass on, but the prayers they prayed for and over us remain. They come to fruition in God's timing. In a lot of ways, I look at my own calling to be much like that of Jonah. Or at least my own initial response to His calling. God sent Jonah to Nineveh. As we know, Jonah had his own ideas and tried to do things his own way. He was afraid to speak to the people of Nineveh, so he tried to run from God's calling and direction. We all know how that worked out for Jonah. Like Jonah, I allowed my own fear to prevent me from doing God's work. Thankfully, it didn't take a big fish for God to get my attention. One year almost to the day after my mother's passing, I was sitting in a meeting at the police department. The Chief of Police came to the briefing room and addressed the officers. He said he was adding a position for department Chaplain. He asked that anyone who was qualified, or knew of someone who was, to contact him. That's when God showed up. A voice in my sprit spoke to me. He said "You don't have to be pastoring a church to be doing My work". After much prayer and contemplation, I went to the Chief and asked about the position. I told him I had never been to seminary, but I felt led by the Lord to look into the position. My Chief was a devout Christian and a leader in his own church's denomination. His response to me still makes me chuckle. In an almost dry wit manner he looked at me and said, "Peter and Paul didn't go to the seminary either". With that he appointed me as Chaplain and started sending me to chaplaincy training courses, thus at least partially fulfilling my mother's vison of me and the ministry. It seems the closer you try to get to God, the more the devil messes with you. It shouldn't be surprising; if you're not trying
