Lessons From Our Horses on The Fruit of the Spirit: The Bond of Love

Galatians 5:22-23 - But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

In my personal Bible study, I have been working through Phillip Keller's book, A Gardener Looks at the Fruits of the Spirit. As an avid gardener myself, I appreciate Keller's writings from the Parable of the Sower about what happens to seeds planted in different types of soil, conditions needed for plant growth and God's expectation that our lives would produce fruit as a result of His work in the gardens of our hearts. As I studied the mysterious ways that God digs out the stones and yanks the weeds

from my stubborn heart, I realized that the ways I train my horses reflect some of the ways God works in my own life to cultivate the fruit of the Spirit listed in Galatians 5:22-23. I have been working a lot with all five of my horses on Liberty skills - which means directing them from the ground at a distance with no halter or lead rope on. As one natural horsemanship instructor says, "When you take off the halter and lead rope, all you have left is the truth about the strength of your relationship with your horse." When starting Liberty, I use a 12-foot rope and a training stick to direct my horses. The first task is asking my horse to yield his hindquarters 180 degrees away from me and face me with two eyes. Sounds a lot like God asking me to leave my sin behind and look at Him, doesn't it? Then I call my horse to me, drawing him hand-over-hand with the 12-foot line and I ask him to gently put the front of his face – his forehead with nose pointed toward the ground - against the front of my jacket. This requires a huge amount of trust from the horse since it puts him in a very vulnerable position - he can't see what's going on around him and he can't run away to safety. As the bond of love and trust develops, I become my horse's safe spot. So true of us with our Sovereign Lord the minute we take one step of faith toward Him, He offers to be our safe spot forever. Next, I ask my horse to follow me as I hold the lead line - around the rail of the arena, then through various obstacles, then halting, backing up, staying and coming to me when I call. Whenever he comes to me, I always invite him to place the front of his face flat on my front, and to relax in that safe spot of my love. When my horse can do these first things well on the 12-foot line, I remove the rope and walk side-by-side with him through all the same tasks - he is free to leave me at any time. This is the first test of the strength of the bond of trust and love between us. As our bond of love and trust strengthens, I stay farther and farther away, and direct my horse through various tasks with voice commands and body language at increasing speeds. So, from across the



arena, I might send him at a trot to a row of 6 barrels laying down and ask him to sidepass over the barrels, or jump them, or squeeze through a narrow opening between two barrels. Or, I might ask him to canter around the rail of the arena, then halt in a slot with a ground pole on one side and back out. And at any moment I might ask him to yield his hindguarters, look at me with two eyes and come trotting back to me to find his safe spot with his face on my front. Without a halter and lead rope on, my horse is free to decide whether to obey me at a distance or disobey and run off. So true of us with God as well when He sends us off to do something for Him – we can choose each moment whether to leave Him and "do our own thing", or to obey and keep our eyes on the Lord! Just as it is the bond of love and trust that keeps my horse with me at Liberty, it is the love of Jesus living in me that motivates and enables me to stick close to Him. And even when my horse asserts his will, kicks up his heels, squeals and runs away from me, the minute he yields his hindquarters and looks at me with two eyes, I invite him back to enjoy his safe spot next to me. So, it is with our loving Lord who graciously invites us back to share the safe spot of His love every time we repent of our willful wanderings.

At that time, I didn't know how to stop what I was already engaged in. For some reason, I always went to church. I had missed one Sunday, and this little eighteen-year-old kid came up and asked me why I didn't go to church. Before I could tell him. I wasn't going back. He told me that the reason he went to church is because he saw me going. I didn't want to be the reason for someone not to go to church, so I started going back again. I was also wondering who else may be going because I was.

The most amazing thing about this is how I went back for the people, but God used that to deliver me. I heard a message by Paster Luben, a volunteer that comes in the Robertson Unit, titled, "Do You Want to Know if You Have the Holy Spirit?" When I heard those words, he had my attention like I was sitting on the front row with my hand to my ear, making sure I didn't miss a word. Now that's just how I felt though,

because I was actually in the back row, but I will never forget the words he said. "This is how you will know if you have the Holy Spirit. If somebody cusses you out and you cuss them out back, and then you feel the Spirit pressed upon your heart to go back and apologize, that's how you know you've got the Holy Spirit. Because He convicts and leads in all truth."

Those words cut straight through my spirit! I remember back in 2004 I gave my life to the Lord Jesus, and since that time, I have been receiving conviction and never knew it. I had even been hearing God's voice telling me that it had been His Word the pastor was telling me. I didn't receive all of this understanding until 2017, but what I did ask was for the Lord to help me change.

I didn't know how to stop selling drugs or stop being loyal to my friends. I used to ask them to release me so that I could do what God was calling me to do, but they said no and that they needed me. Many nights, I cried under the covers, asking God to give me a chance. I told Him that I was not strong enough to let go, that He was going to have to take the things that I was holding on to. To take the pain of my daughter growing up with only one living parent. To take the pain of me not being in her life due to the bad decisions I have made. To take the pain of me not being able to read or write. Surprisingly though, the Lord took it!

I got busted for conspiracy to bring synthetic marijuana onto the unit with a correction officer. I got G5 and was confined to a cell for twenty-three hours a day for the next twelve months. I experienced God in a way that I never thought possible. I only had the New Testament Bible, and I went from not knowing how to read, to reading from eight to twelve hours a day; just the Bible. Outside of my Bible, I read my first book by Charles Stanley called "Man of God." All of this took place in close custody isolation. God completely changed everything. Another six months after that was spent on median custody where I began to walk by faith. While I was in close custody, God was showing me visions of me preaching. I

asked God how I was supposed to preach when I couldn't even read. As you can now see, God changed that. He gave me the ability and I began to serve God however He needed me. Singing songs, when I can't sing, but I did it for Him. Mopping floors and shaking hands, whatever it took. He allowed me to serve with my brother.

It has only been three years of actually walking out His word of faith, but it has been the best of my life. Today I know who I am, and I know what I am called to do. My name is DeRome Patterson, and it is an honor and a privilege to be ordained as a cowboys Chaplain. May this testimony bare fruit in the lives of the readers. And the Word of God says, "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the words of their testimony." **Revelations 12:11**

from Brett James Martinson (Editor's note: writer will receive the Christian Ranchman, Bible and Bible studies)

Dear Christian Ranchman, I have been in and out of prison my whole life and did 25 years flat from 1993 to 2018 and came back with another 12 years sentence. When I was young until coming to prison I lived on my grandpa and grandma cattle ranch in New Waverly, Texas and worked stock since I was old enough to sit and handle a cow horse. I always wanted to be a cattleman like my grandpa and dad, but started running with the wrong crowd and got into a lot of trouble and drugs while riding bulls on the PRCA Rodeo Circuit as a Bronze Card holder and thought the drug, crank made me a better rider and unbeatable. That was just another lie from Satan and I now see that too!

At 24 years old I committed the murder of my best friend and got 25 years and did it day for day because when I got to prison, I joined a prison gang and started acting up, big time. I got confirmed as a gang member and put in Ag-seg (23/7 lockdown) in a cell by myself, and I did it for 22 years, until released in Nov. 20, 2018.

I went back to the family ranch and was blessed with a great job and started building a relationship with my son and daughter, who were now grown adults. My son's son and soon to be wife, who had shown my son the love of Jesus that had completely made my son, a man of God.

I was out 3 years when my daughter's boyfriend put his hands on her and I handled it as a sinning father would and got 12 years for aggressive assault with a deadly weapon. Now, I am back in prison and even through I'm no longer a prison gang member, I'm back in Ad. Seg, because I was still talking to others who were still active members. They were my friends for over 20 years, but it is not allowed, so I was locked back in Ad-Seg as a confirmed member. But I'm at the Michael Unit and by God's grace I met a guy named Tommy who is also a Christian and the other night he showed me your newspaper (Christian Ranchman) and I fell in love with it. It shows the absolute love Christ has for us and shows it truly in a way I can relate to.

Could I please receive your *Christian Ranchman*? And a Cowboys For Christ Holy Bible, as well? I pray that this letter finds all of those at the *Christian Ranchman* and Cowboys For Christ in the highest of blessings and the best of health, as well as all y'alls families, too!! Eph 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.


Veteran's Day




