Seven: Cowboys For Christ
Ministry Team

The Cowboys for Christ Ministry Team was established through ordination by the Cowboys for Christ Chaplains of America Ministries. Warden J. Cozby opened a pathway for these Cowboy Chaplains to begin trail-blazing for God's Kingdom. Since

then, these trail blazers for God's Kingdom have earned the nickname: "The Magnificent Seven".

The fields are ripe and ready for harvest and the Magnificent Seven are in the fields. In Genesis 3:23, the word says: Therefore the Lord God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. To till means to work by plowing, sowing and raising crops, cultivate.

When we truly begin to do the work of the Lord, God has specific steps for us to take and the first one is plowing. [Plowing means to open up; also to break-up.] Any time we engage in a relationship, you have to be willing to open up; be transparent through the truth which will ultimately break up the barriers so the truth can begin to enter into the relationship. By this being done intentionally it will give birth to the second step.

[Sowing: sowing means to plant seeds, to scatter abroad.] It's a beautiful thing to see the heart receive the word of God through fellowship. This fellowship is multifaceted, meaning: demonstrated through one on one seed planting moments, or group fellowship which allows the seeds to be scattered abroad to the multitudes, which leads us to step 3.

This is one of the most crucial steps. I once heard that ministry is compared to doing surgery. We are opening peo-ple up, taking out all of the bad and putting in the good. Then we have to stitch them up. Then begin the healing therapy. If this step is not properly completed, someone can die. We could lose the person or/people that God has placed in our care. That is why raising, which is step 3, is so important. [Raising means: to help to rise, awaken the dead, grow, to bring to maturity]. As a child of God, we truly know the importance of receiving help so that we can rise above our circumstances in life. When God's power has brought forth a resurrection, not just in our lives, but in the lives of our brothers and sisters as well, we all benefit spiritually as well as emotionally. This raising will cause anyone to be brought to maturity. When these steps are followed, under the unction of the Holy Spirit, we will

truly understand the meaning of cultivate.

The meaning of cultivate is: [to prepare and improve, to tend and grow; to seek the good will of.] What Jesus did on the Cross was to save all of us! [2 Peter 3:9, The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.]

## Guy's Testimony by Chaplain Guy Graves

Howdy fellow Cowboys and Cowgirls out there. I am Cowboy Chaplain Guy Graves here on the Robertson Unit. Just letting you all know that I have been serving with my fellow Chaplains here working to advance the kingdom agenda. Every week for three years I have along with other men went into the hard to reach places within the Robertson Unit to preach the word. During those years hundreds of men have given their lives to Christ. Due to staffing issues and their custody level I have not been able to baptize them.

Yet in the fullness of time, God provid-ed a mobile baptismal and on March 4th I baptized 16 men in Restrictive Housing who confessed and received Christ as their Lord. Recently Dave sent in some Bible studies and Bibles to us via Cowboy Chaplain Tommy Tutt and I have 12 men doing them at this time. Every day I walked around the unit talking to men daily counseling, teaching and spreading the gospel. Furthermore, I help conduct other church services on the unit and we had a combined baptism service where I baptized 25 more men out of the 56 who got baptized on May 24, 2024. The harvest is plentiful and we are hard at work every day going into the brush to flush out the strays bringing them in to be branded with the cross. None of this would be possible without the guidance of Tommy Tutt who has led us by being Christ -like in all his words and deeds.

Thank you all for allowing us to be a part of such a great mission.

One of the brakes on her trailer locked up, so we had to get that fixed first. Finally, with that fixed, we loaded the horse and headed north. Two hours later we were unloading the horse at his new pasture. The owner was grateful and tried to pay us for the trip, but we declined. You know, doing things for others is just the cowboy way. We take care of each other.

We stood around talking, watching the horse explore his new pasture. Before we knew it the owner was opening up to us about problems and issues she was facing with kids and finances. This lady has had a rough couple of years. Her husband died from covid a few years ago leaving her with five kids to raise by herself. A little over a year later, her son died from brain cancer. My wife spent the next two and a half or three hours ministering to her right there at the pasture. This mom found herself in tears of joy, standing beside a horse trailer knowing that God cared enough about her to send a couple that was willing to take their whole Saturday to meet a need she had and show God's love to her.

Many people restrict their understanding of where and how ministry takes place to Sunday morning worship and sermon. I think Jesus met people where they were and ministered to them on the spot. Jesus ministered in the streets, in the market place, on mountain side and from a boat just off shore. He ministered to people in the wilderness, while seating at the well in Samaria, while walking down the road and yes, in the Synagogue. #### HELP AND COMFORT

**Ps 94:16-19 16** Who will rise up for me against the wicked? Who will stand up for me against the evildoers? 17 Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul would have soon lived in silence. 18 When I said, "My foot is slipping!" Your loving kindness, LORD, held me up. 19 In the multitude of my thoughts within me, your comforts delight my soul.

Help and comfort or fear and anxiety! All four are certainly apparent in this troubled and evil world, but who gets what and when. The adversary sure wants to add to any and all problems and if he

can add fear and anxiety to our everyday lives, then he will certainly make the most of every opportunity. He also has a bunch of minions, some in very high places and with much authority, to add to the problems, which undoubtedly increases the fear and anxiety. And according to our text, this is not a modern situation or something that is new to our human existents on this earth. We have uncountable amounts of mercy, grace and love from the Lord, but we certainly need the faith, and his strength and ability to stand strong during times of attack.

Who do you go to for help and comfort. I know it is of little concern when everything is great and all is well, but things normally don't stay that way all of the time. The devil sure likes to sneak into our lives and disrupt our peace and comfort. He has made a special effort to be the liar that he is famous for; always spreading his untruth or half lies to make life a living hell and he is really good at his business. Plus, he is not at all lazy or caring about what he does, when he does it and how he does it, so we certainly need to be prayed up, studied up and seeking the Lord Jesus Christ, at all times and in every way. The writer in our text was evidently under heavy attack and he was laying out his battle plan and he declared victory, which he has readily revealed to us. God's Word is the battle plan and for sure, the way to victory, but we need to follow this time honored and proven way to victory and eternal life from the holy God. The holy Word of God is such a wonderful gift to mankind, and we certainly have the living Word of God to guide us through the pitfalls, trials and problems of this trouble world and on to eternal victory. And God's living Word is still the same as it was when the Holy Spirit led writer of Psalm 94 penned these wonderful words for us to read, heed and follow. They are here for us, but are you receiving this life providing, life comforting, life protecting and eternal life-giving directions: daily. And I am talking about you setting down and reading and studying God's Holy Word and seeking his will and plan for your life, every day.

Not only do we have God's Word, but we have free, paid in full, always available, direct communication with the Holy God in which we can take our needs, our desires, our trials, our tribulations and our battles directly into the throne room of the Holy God. We are very special to the Father, and we also have a High Priest who is the sinless Son of God and who readily understands our weakness and even our sinfulness. "Heb 4:14-16 14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are — yet was without sin. 16 Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need." I was a born and raised Christian. I was brought up in the Methodist Church. I have been a believer ever since I can remember. Problem was I haven't always been a true follower of Jesus Christ. Oh, I always went to church. I went to youth group, and ever prayed before my wrestling matches. But, then the temptations of this world and Satan led me astray. My world kind of fell apart.





I got married, was blessed with a pair of twins, one boy and one girl. Four years later I got divorced. Not exactly the way I had it planned. A few years later I remarried. We had a girl and then two years later we had a boy.

My son was born with a tumor on his kidney and was moved to the University of Kentucky Children's Hospital. Four days after he was born the surgeon went in and removed the tumor and the kidney. We thought everything was going to be good after the surgery. Four days later we were told that after the procedure our son's stomach had died. Before we could get back to the hospital, the surgeon had gone back in and removed the stomach and spleen. The next couple days saw no improvement. An associate Pastor from our church came to the hospital and we had a dedication ceremony for our son. You

could tell the pastor was struggling a bit, I think he was new to this situation. The nurse that was taking care of our boy was present at the time, and she opened her Bible and started reading. After the dedication my wife and I went home to make some hard decisions.

Later, I ended up on the steps of our church. I really wanted the security of being at the altar, but there was no way to get inside, so, I settled for the front steps. I prayed to our Lord and Savior to heal our son. I also asked God to take me and let my son live. I know that bargaining was not what I should be doing. I was blessed that night by one prayer received and one prayer ignored. I was allowed to live and the next morning the nurse called and said that not long after the dedication our son made a complete turn-around for the better and was going to make it. Three months later there was an experimental surgery and a pouch was made out of the small intestines. It took three years for our son to eat by mouth. I know there was a reason he was born to the mother he has. He is 21 years old now and I was blessed that night to still be here to see it.

I don't remember the nurse's name that took care of our son and finished the dedication, but we went back to the hospital to see her and she had left the hospital. I am pretty sure she was our son's Angel. An Angel on earth or from heaven above, still an Angel!!


