

We travel to 35 rodeos a year, set up a canopy and a table and offer free Bibles to rodeo staff and contestants and minister. This past weekend was no exception. As I was looking over my notes to deliver the sermon for cowboy church, the owner of the rodeo company walked over carrying a square bale of hay and set it down near the bull pin. The bulls were laying down resting having completed their days work and really didn't even notice him. Then he took out his knife and cut the first baling string. I'm sure you are familiar with that sound they make when the pressure is released. So were the bulls. At that sound, they jumped up and before he could cut the second string they were all standing at the railing waiting for the hay to come.

Psalms 122:1 (NLT) I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go to the house of the LORD.

Matthew 5:6 (KJV) Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

I couldn't help but notice the parallel between the action or response of those bulls and these scriptures. If we as Christians were as

hungry for God's word and His presence as these bulls were for that hay, things would be a lot different in our lives. Many of the things I do today will be things I have to do but some will be a matter of choice. A response to my priorities. If God's word is a priority in my life, I will find a way to make time for it. If talking to God is a priority, I will find a way to spend some time in prayer. Let's be like those bulls with the hay. Let's make God, his word and his presence a priority in our life.


Dear Cowboys For Christ, I wanted to thank you for the beautiful Bible that you sent to me. It means a lot to me. I will cherish it always.

My Testimony

My name is Francisco J. Zapata, I was arrested on April 6, 1995. I was 16 years old, under murder charges, at that age I was in street gang lifestyle. I come from a good home, but I was a rebel. I only lasted around a year and 8 months in Texas, before I was arrested. I came from Mexico, an immigrant family. Being so young and under this charge, I continued my crazy youth and I got into prison gang and become a dangerous person. I ended up in segregation on Oct of 99 for my prison gang lifestyle. When I was in segregation it hit me, nothing was making sense for me, my gang family or nothing. Later this volunteer came around and shared Jesus with me. I had this deep conversion, and surrender my life to Jesus, as my Lord and Savior. I started to read the Bible for the first time from Genesis to Revelation. The next week the volunteer came again and gave me some Christian Material and so my life started to have a meaning. 2000 till 2009 I studied the Bible like nothing else; Greek, Hebrew, Bible translations and religion. I wanted to know Jesus and how my faith will save me and guide me to the life in Jesus. Then on 2009 I was given the chance to get out of segregation in November. I was finally released to population again and went to try to go to church. I saw nothing but religion and sinful lifestyle, so I got away from God, church and reading the Bible. I thought I was good enough and if the church was like that I was better alone. The last of May of 2024, I went to Kairos, and I returned to Jesus! I was a real prodigal son, who turned away from Jesus!! After Kairos in 2024, I got back and the Lord Jesus has restored me, has put this peace and hunger for Him. I being in the unit for 9 years all the cowboy Chaplains know me, because I am real athletic and because I was not the type of person to get upset, curse and because I am in the craft shop. But since Kairos of 2024, my life has turned and the Lord has been really gracious to me. And everyone has seen the change, even when I don't try or say a word. I just

glad God has saved me again and brought me back to His Son.

I have a solid Christian foundation and love for my Lord and Savior and a hunger to grow to what He has planned for my life. On June 20, 2023, I got a 5-year set-up on parole! I was going to wait till I got out to come to serve Christ, like in a ministry, but this parole denied hit me hard. What really helped me was faith. I started a Bible study with one brother in my dorm, So, why I was waiting until I got out, I better start now.

I know both languages, but focus more on Spanish, and I see that there is no help for non-English speaking people. So, God put this on my heart, to try to be a cowboy Chaplain for the Spanish brothers. I realized that everything that has happened is of the Lord. He had this planned for me, because I was not ready for the free world. So, I am just surrendering myself to Him.

The Florida Cowboys For Christ Conference 2025



Riding Point With Dave Harvey...

STEPHEN AND CHARLIE - THE SPIRITUAL BATTLE



Acts 6:8-10 8 Stephen, full of grace and power, performed great wonders and signs among the people. 9 But some of those who were of the synagogue called "The Libertines," and of the Cyrenians, of the Alexandrians, and of those of Cilicia and Asia arose, disputing with Stephen. 10 They weren't able to withstand the wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke.

Acts 8:2 Devout men buried Stephen, and lamented greatly over him.

The similarities of the New Testament Stephen (Acts 6-7-8) and Charlie Kirk are striking, especially when you compare the description of Stephen in the verses of our text. Stephen was a dynamic young man who was greatly anointed to step out in faith and serve the Lord during a very difficult time. Stephen is described as being "full of grace and power" which is also translated in the KJV as "full of faith and power" and he used that grace, faith and power to do great thing for the Lord. And Charlie Kirk has certainly accomplished the same and greatly proved his faith, the power of the Holy Spirit working in his life, and in his great service for the Lord in touching so many of today's youth in colleges and high schools all across this nation.

We are absolutely a people in mourning of the murder of Charlie Kirk, just like the believers at the time of Stephen's tragic murder. Christians all around the world, and especially in this nation, are certainly mourning the heartbreaking, tragic murder of a great man of God, Charlie Kirk. After founding Turning Point USA in 2012, Charlie put himself on the front lines of taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the college campuses and high schools throughout the nation. And then he extended his reach, by going to other nations, to share Jesus Christ and the truth of God's Holy Word and debate the sinfulness and evil of today's youth and those in all walks of sociality. Both Stephen and Charlie very seriously took the Great Commission from our Lord in: "Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you. You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the uttermost parts of the earth." And they greatly proved this in their lives and service to the Lord. Stephen, filled with the Holy Spirit never backed down when debating difficult subjects, especially sinfulness and the truth and Charlie Kirk certainly never backed down or avoided these issues either. And they both gave their lives in a very heartbreaking way to prove their dedication and commitment to these truths, and especially to the Lord. They were mighty warriors of the cross of Jesus Christ in this spiritual battle against sin and evil.

Charlie would take the controversial topics of the sinful lifestyles that are so prevalent throughout the world today and declared the truth of the evil of this type of living. He always focused on the salvation message of the cross of Jesus Christ, and how with Jesus, you could change your life and live for Him for a much better life in this sin torn world, and have eternal life, too. And in doing so, Charlie went into the very "pits-of-hell" to debate and try to persuade the young folks that the results of this type of sinful living will always produce the same effects; pain, heartache, grief, sorrow, broken relationships and eventually eternal death. Charlie, like Stephen, was a great man of God, a great witness for our Lord, and certainly filled with the Holy Spirit and assuredly both were great men of faith. Which means that both great men of God gave their lives fighting the spiritual battle of good versus evil and the rampant sinfulness promoted by the devil and his many puppets.

Stephen was such a mighty man of God that he was blessed to preach his own funeral, as we see in: Acts 7:1-53. As Stephen declared the truth to the religious leaders, the Sanhedrin and the High Priest, who were presiding over this court session, as charges were brought against Stephen. Stephen declared that they and their ancestors were guilty of murdering the prophets and now the Messiah, God's own Son, Jesus Christ. And with this declared truth by Stephen, they seized him and took him outside of the city of Jerusalem and stone him to death, which made them guilty of murdering him, too. And as we know Charlie Kirk was murdered just a few weeks ago, and he was just as innocent and truthful as Stephen. And this was certainly the wicked results of the continued spiritual battle going on since the Garden of Eden, and not a political battle, as so many are trying to distort the truth of both of these acts of murder.

Actually, we have another young man who was especially ordained by God to declare the truth of Jesus Christ and the truth of sinful living and he gave his life doing it: John the Baptist. And each one of them were about the same age as our Lord and Savior. Plus, each one is with their Lord in the glory of God's holy Kingdom right now, at this very moment, and will be for all eternity. But what about their killers? What about the many men that were involved in stoning Stephen for telling the truth. And what about the young man that pulled the trigger and took the life of Charlie Kirk? Actually, I know for sure that any or all of those men could be just like the Apostle Paul and are joining Stephen in Heaven, if they have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord. Just as the man who killed Charlie has the chance of joining Charlie, if he would repent, turn his life around and accept Jesus Christ as his Savior and Lord, too.

It is certainly time for God's children to become warriors and servants and step out in faith to declare sin, as just actually what it is "sin." If you are a child of God, and have accepted Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord, then this is your fight and it is your wake-up call to action.







My Personal Testimony

As many Americans, I attended church basically since I was born. I heard the Bible stories, went to Sunday School and what we called "big church" for worship and the sermon. When I was seven years old, I decided to accept Jesus and be baptized. Whether or not I understood most of what I was doing I'm not sure, but was more so of an agreement than what I would call true faith. I continued attending church for about ten more years and got to a point where I refused as a teenager. Looking back, it was likely due to an incompatibility of my lifestyle with what church was about, though I doubt I was aware of this. At the time, I just knew I didn't want to go and thought (or at least used the excuse) that everyone at church were hypocrites, possibly just assuming they were all like me.

Fast forward a few years and a heap of bad habits later, I can say I was actually leaning on Scripture in hard times, though I had no idea what God wanted me to know. I clung to promises from Psalms and convinced myself I didn't know what the heavier parts meant. For several years I would say I knew God was there but because I didn't understand (supposedly) enough about Jesus I would say I wasn't sure of him. As time progressed and I made more sense of everything, I started trusting more of the Bible and would've called myself a Christian again.

By the time I was about 30 years old I was beginning to understand that the more literally I took Scripture as the truth, the more it made sense to me. This is when God "sent me to the desert" so to speak, I found myself in very dark spiritual circumstances and had no idea what to do. I visited pastors seeking answers and spent days and nights on end in prayer and worship. One clear message I received at the time was that there was a need to stop sinning.

Obviously, I had heard this many times in church, but in accordance with my nature at the time, I just told myself that it was okay, because I thought my sins to be covered anyway. As the dark days and nights continued, I persevered through prayer and worship.

It seemed that I could see the light on the other side of the tunnel and was eventually released from the affliction. It was "on my way out of the tunnel" that I was on my knees in prayer and can recall the moment I found a great new affection for holiness. Shortly after, Jesus provided me with assurance of salvation.

Yes, I was aware of this aspect, which was absolutely amazing, but because I was still lacking knowledge of the Bible, I didn't actually know what had happened in theological terms. What I did know was what I had been given and that I was beginning to see several victories over sin that had been very large parts of my life.

It took about three years until, after finding myself binge-watching street ministry videos, that I finally realized what had happened in October of 2020. I had been born again! This of course, is the only power that can give man the power of righteousness to overcome sin. The power of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. The power of the only Spirit and source that has overcome sin and death! The power of my sin being nailed to the cross and Jesus imputing His righteousness to me! I realize this may not be how a lot of people may be born again. I realize that faith and repentance may happen right at the beginning for many people, but this was simply not the case for me. I could probably be called hard-headed for much of my life before this, but I do fear that this may be the case for many people that grow up in the Christian households in the United States. Especially as many doctrines fill the country that were not derived from Scripture, but from men's hearts which are deceitful.

The true Gospel is my motivation for the Great Commission moving forward. To boldly, but in gentleness, share the truth of the Gospel

of Jesus Christ that has the power to change lives and save people from sin and death. To lead others by prayer and preaching and by blessing and grace of God to eternal life in Christ Jesus!





Restored

As I was growing up, my Dad had a good friend who owned a construction company. His friend would garner work for himself on the weekends and whenever he had days off from the company he worked for. He soon began approaching my Dad for his help, whenever he got jobs too big for him to handle alone or take too long to be cost effective. My Dad would not refuse such financial opportunities. He actually had great interest in the trade. So, my Dad began assisting his friend and, in turn, gained the knowledge and skills of the trade. Soon my Dad started taking me along with him, whether I wanted to go. But soon, I realized that I began to have a level of interest in the work.

After a time, my Dad developed a good experience of the trade. And I wasn't so bad either. Dad began getting job offers

of his own. He and his friend continued to work together whenever projects were too large to handle on their own.

The jobs my Dad obtained were mainly for owners of old houses. It typically meant a room needed to be gutted and remolded, cabinets taken down and replaced or refurbished, floors dismantled and re-laid, or doors and windows replaced with new ones. No matter how difficult or simple these restoration jobs were, my Dad would never refuse one. He saw accepting the job as another opportunity to become a better carpenter.

Taking out, or bringing down, the old to bring in the new certainly wasn't easy work. We had to cut boards, pull nails, yank wire, beat on things, hammer a lot, drill, rip and tear it all for the sake of restoration. Even now as I think back, I can imagine those old inanimate objects which constituted a house (boards, nails, wiring, etc.), moaning and groaning as we inflicted our restoration efforts upon them, replacing the old for the new. I could almost hear the silent cries of "ouch" and the inaudible exclamations of discomfort as we pulled out nails and hammered new ones in. Do not laugh at me having such an imagination.

God's word tells us in Romans 8:21-22 Everything God made would be free from ruin. There was hope that everything God made would have freedom and glory that belong to God's children. We know that everything God made has been waiting until now like a woman ready to give birth to a child. (ERV)

In other words, all of creation is moaning and laboring, waiting to be delivered from the taint and stench of corruption. Therefore, it is not hard to imagine all inanimate objects of creation moaning and groaning as we, by our sin, affect them.

Restoration is no easy process, whether with inanimate (things) or the animate (living). From Genesis to Revelation, in a sense, is all about God's program to restore fallen man to fellowship with Himself. God tells us in Leviticus 20:7 "Be special.
